

TONIGHT'S GAME

Oregon State comes into tonight's game against Florida State having registered an 86-81 victory over Miami last night on the Hurricanes' home court.

Sophomore guard Bill Nickleberry was the sparkplug for the Beavers with a 24-point performance, 18 coming in the final half. Vince Fritz was next in the scoring column with 18, including 10 of 11 from the free throw line. Larry Webber came off the bench for 13 points, one more than guard Freddie Boyd.

The Pacific Eight Conference club, a darkhorse title contender in its league, trailed Miami 40-38 at halftime before making a move. The Hurricanes got a 42-point effort from guard Don Curnutt.

The eventual difference came at the free throw line where Oregon State hit 28 of 34 for 82% to Miami's 21 of 31 for 68%. The Beavers also out-rebounded the Hurricanes 40-35.

Oregon State is expected to start Nickleberry and Boyd at guards, seven-foot Dick Bartolome at center with Vince Fritz and Tim Perkins at forwards.

Florida State will counter with Dave Cowens at the high post, Vernell Ellzy at the low post, Skip Young and Rowland Garrett on the wings and Ken Macklin at the point.

Nickleberry, who starred as a freshman for the Beavers before spending two years in the Army, had an outstanding game against Miami. The 5-8 speedster hit on 10 of 13 shots from the field and 4 of 5 from the line. He also had four assists and five rebounds.

Tonight's officials are Bill Bennett and Bobby Brock.
