

TONIGHT'S GAME

There is no place like home and Florida State's Seminole basketball team is certainly glad to be back after spending the better part of two weeks on a five-game tour that stretched from Jacksonville on the Atlantic to Los Angeles on the Pacific.

Coach Hugh Durham's Tribe won four of those contests, including the Championship at the Gator Bowl Tournament. With their record at 10-2, the Seminoles will play four of their next six here at Tully Gym.

Miami brings a 5-6 record into tonight's battle, but the Hurricane's are unbeaten "this year", winning both their 1970 starts.

Once again the Seminoles will be challenged to stop the 'Canes outstanding guard, Don Curnutt. The 6-3 senior, averaging 27 points a game, has been slowed by a kidney infection and played only four minutes in Miami's 105-95 win over Rhode Island Monday night. But he is ready and has played some of his best ball against the Seminoles.

Joining Curnutt will be 6-7 forward Wayne Canaday (17.2), and 6-6 center Willie Allen (15.1). The other forward post will probably go to 6-2 Mike Hutsler, who came off the bench Monday and scored 20 points. The Hurricanes playmaker is 6-1 John Welch.

The Seminoles will go with the same five who have started the past several contests. Ken Macklin will be at the point, with Skip Young and Ron Harris on the wings. The post men will be Willie Williams and Dave Cowens.

The series is the oldest, in terms of games played, for the Seminoles. Tonight's game is the 41st meeting between the two schools. They have split the first 40, 20-20.
