

TONIGHT'S GAME

Atlantic Coast Conference member Clemson brings a 4-7 record into tonight's game with Florida State. The Tigers are a much-improved club since forward Ritchie Mahaffey became eligible four games ago.

Proof of Clemson's improvement came Monday night when the Tigers knocked off a good Georgia Tech team, 88-78, Monday night after the Jackets led by 17 points during the first half.

Mahaffey gives Clemson more rebounding strength as he joins Ronnie Yates and Greg Latin in the front line.

In guard Butch Zatezalo, the Tigers have one of the finest shooters in the country. The 5-11 senior from Aliquippa, Pa., has led the ACC in scoring for the past two seasons and is currently averaging 21.4. The other guard, Dave Thomas, is averaging 14.8 points while Latin, a 6-7 sophomore, is scoring at a 16.6 clip.

Meantime, Florida State puts its 12-2 record on the line. The Seminoles are third in the country in team rebounding and senior Dave Cowens is ninth individually with 17.3 average.

At the low post will be senior Willie Williams, playing sensational ball since given a starting assignment against Louisville Dec. 22. In that nine-game span, the 6-7 Miami native is averaging 17.8 points and has brought his rebounding average up to 10.5 for the season.

At the wings will be junior Skip Young and sophomore Ron Harris. It was Young's second half performance against Tulane last Saturday night which helped the Seminoles register an 82-77 victory. Young counted 15 points over the final 20 minutes after being blanked at halftime when the Seminoles were down by seven.

Senior Ken Macklin, averaging 9.8 points, will open at the point position.
