

TONIGHT'S GAME

It's back to earth time for the Seminoles. The Tribe's 89-83 win over Jacksonville Tuesday night was pleasing, but Coach Hugh Durham's crew must turn their thoughts to more immediate situations now--like tonight's upset minded opponent, Virginia Tech.

The Seminoles got a look at the Gobblers in the Gator Bowl Tournament last month in Jacksonville, although the two teams did not meet. Tech lost both its games (to Florida and Army) by a total of five points.

Since then they have won five of eight to lift their record to 6-8 for the season. Tech started the year with a controlled offense, but Coach Howie Shannon has shuffled his starters and opened up the offense.

In the last six contests the Gobblers have averaged 76 points a game compared to 63 in the first eight. Tech will probably start Tom Trice (6.7) and Wayne Lockett (9.7) at forward, Charlie Lipscomb (11.4) at center with Loyd King (17.6) and Bill McNeer (10.5) at the guard spots.

The Seminoles will again go with Ken Macklin at the point, Skip Young and Ron Harris on the wings, Dave Cowens at high post and Willie Williams at low post. Vernell Ellzy, as he has in most of the recent games, is expected to see a lot of duty, also.

The Seminoles and Gobblers have three opponents in common--Florida, Army and Clemson. Tech lost to all three: 48-45 to the Gators, 57-55 to Army and 87-79 to Clemson. The Seminoles defeated all three, 88-63, 86-51, 122-80.

The two teams met for the first time last year and Tech upset the Seminoles 77-74 in Blacksburg.
