

TONIGHT'S GAME

Tulane, talented and always troublesome for Florida State, provides the opposition tonight as the Seminoles hope to protect their ninth ranking nationally and at the same time go for their second highest number of victories.

Coach Hugh Durham's club brings a 19-2 record into the game and a 20th triumph would better the 19 recorded by the 1967-68 Seminoles.

The visiting Greenies own a 5-12 mark but have been scoring at a sizzling pace. In the last three contests, Tulane is averaging 103.7 points. Despite this scoring rate, the Greenies dropped two of those last three contests.

Tulane is expected to open with 6-7 Greg Robers and 6-8 John Sutter at forwards, 6-6 Harold Sylvester at center with 5-10 Mike Henry and 6-1 Ned Reese at guards.

Sutter is the country's 23rd leading scorer with a 26.1 average while Sylvester (12.4) and Reese (13.2) are also in double figures.

Seminole Dave Cowens has a chance to become Florida State's fourth-leading scorer of all-time tonight if he collects nine points. A nine-point production would move him in front of his coach with 1,382 points. He is within easy reach of the No. 3 man--Ham Wernke at 1,409.

Other starters tonight include Willie Williams at the low post, Skip Young and Ron Harris at the wings with Ken Macklin at the point.

Williams has a string of 16 straight games in double figures.
