

FLORIDA STATE VS SOUTH DAKOTA

Florida State carries a two-game victory string into its first meeting with South Dakota tonight.

The visiting Coyotes were 0-1 going into last night's game against Memphis State.

Coach Hugh Durham will open with the same five players who started when the Seminoles downed Texas 80-78 and Biscayne 106-70.

That means Vernell Ellzy goes at the low post, 6-11 Reggie Royals high, Otto Petty at the point with Ron King and Rowland Garrett on the wings.

Ellzy, the Sanford senior, had an outstanding night against Biscayne when he hit 46 points and pulled down 16 rebounds. The former Seminole JC All-America is averaging 23 points in two contests and shares the rebounding lead with Royals at 12 each.

Among the starters Royals is averaging 11 points and 12 rebounds, King 18 points and 3.5 rebounds, Garrett 13 points and 6 rebounds and Petty 7 points. The 5-7 Petty is on a record-setting course in the assist department since he has had 21 successful feeds in two contests.

Junior Ron Harris turned in an outstanding performance against Biscayne as the sixth man. The former Key West High School All-America came off the bench to hit for 11 points and get 11 rebounds.

As a team the Seminoles are shooting 52.1 percent from the field to the opposition's 34.9.

Coach Hugh Durham is still not satisfied with his club's rebounding. So far, the Seminoles have only out-rebounded their opponents 109-96.

South Dakota is a young team which will likely go with four sophomores and a junior tonight. That combination would be forwards Mark Wiedenfeld (6-5) and Doug Moody (6-5), center Chuck Iverson (6-9) along with guards Tom Resner (6-1) and Steve Moses (6-0). There is a possibility that junior Bill Utecht (6-6½) might start in place of Moody.
