

FLORIDA STATE VS MIAMI

Florida State and Miami face off for the 43rd time tonight, as the Tribe's oldest rivalry moves into its 20th season. The Seminoles have dominated the series the last couple of years, winning the last five games to take a 22-20 overall advantage, And Miami has not won in Tully Gym since 1960.

The Hurricanes come into tonight's game with a 3-6 record, including an 89-81 win Monday night over Seton Hall. They are not tall, with 6-6 center Willie Allen the tallest starter, but the 'Canes are a "physically strong team."

Joining Allen in the starting lineup are forwards Lee Hubbard (6-5) and Richard Klein (6-3), guards Donald Strong (6-3) and Lionel Harris (6-3). Allen and Strong lead the scorers with 16.8 and 16.3 averages respectively.

Coach Hugh Durham will go with the same starting lineup that has carried the Seminoles to an 8-3 record, including a current three game winning streak. That will have Ron King and Rowland Garrett on the wings, Otto Petty at the point, Vernell Ellzy at low post and Reggie Royals high.

One of the prime reasons for the Seminoles' success this year, has been their shooting accuracy. As a team the Tribe is shooting .502 and the five starters are hitting a composite 54 percent.

The Seminoles next home game is Monday night when they host Manhattan College.
