



Florida State Basketball 1971-72

With four or five starters returning from a club which went 17-9 last year, there is the potential for an outstanding season. "But potential doesn't win ball games," warns Seminole Coach Hugh Durham, "only performance does."

Ámong the returnees is senior forward Rowland Garrett. Joining him will be juniors Reggie Royals,

Ron King and Otto Petty.

King and Garrett are the good bets to keep their positions from last season. The 6-4 King is destined to become one of the Seminoles all-time scoring leaders. No better "natural shooter" has worn Florida State colors. Last year he led the team with a 22.7 average and broke the Tribe's single game scoring record with 46 points against Georgia Southern.

Petty, at 5-7 one of the smallest collegiate basketball players, was a starter at the point most of last

season, when he made a record 227 assists. This year he is receiving a strong challenge from 5-8 senior Greg Samuel and 6-2 sophomore Otis Cole.

Cole is one of two sophomores with a shot at becoming a starter this year. Lawrence McCray (6-11) appears to be the choice to fill Ellzy's vacated low post spot.

Other lettermen who return and figure big in the plans this season are senior Ron Harris and junior Larry Gay.

In addition to McCray and Cole there are four other sophomores who figure in the plans. Artie

Fryer, 6-5, and Jim Calkin, 6-4, add depth at the wing spots, while 6-7 hopefuls John Amick and Bill Wright will see time at the post positions.

Durham Former FSU Star

In five years Hugh Durham has transformed Florida State basketball into one of the nation's more respected and consistently ranked teams.

Durham has reached two of those goals set five years ago. In 1967-68, the Seminoles went to the NCAA Mid-East Regional Tournament. The 1969-70 season saw the Tribe

running off to a 23-3 record and lofty national rankings throughout the season. A national championship is the third goal.

This will be Durham's 13th season at Florida State, either as a coach or player. A graduate of Eastern High in Louisville where he earned a total of 14 letters in basketball, baseball, football and track, Durham chose Florida State over several other schools.

He scored 1,381 points in three varsity seasons with two 500-plus years. He was an Honorable mention All-America, graduating in 1960.

Florida State Founded In 1857


Florida State University's 10 schools and colleges are the several academic homes of more than 17,000 students in 1971—students who hail from the four corners of the world as well as the home state.

This public, coeducational institution of higher learning is one of nine in the State University System of Florida. Founded in 1857, it is the second oldest university in the public system and a senior leader in graduate education and research programs.

Although Seminole sports can be traced back to the first decade of the 20th Century, the University's history includes a number of years when it was known as the Florida State College for Women (1902-47). The dynamic growth of intercollegiate athletics, since coeducation and university status came to the campus in 1947, has paralleled the phenomenal physical and enrollment growth of the institution in the last two and one-half decades.

Academically and athletically, Florida State is a contender for top ranking among the nation's leading universities. Earlier this year, the American Council of Education rated eight Florida State graduate programs in the physical, biological and social science areas among the better programs in the nation, giving chemistry the highest rating of "strong and distinguished." Two Nobel Laureates have been added to the faculty roster—one a full-time, the other on an annual winter quarter basis.

One of only 24 institutions in the country which confers more than 100 Ph.D. degrees each year, Flor-

ida State is now graduating an average of 5,000 students annually from its College of Arts and Sciences, Education and Law, and from its Schools of Home Economics, Music, Library Science, Social Welfare, Business, Nursing, and Engineering Science.

At the undergraduate level, Florida State students have a choice of more than 95 different baccalaureate fields of study; and at the graduate level, a choice of more than 85 master's degree areas and more than 55 doctoral programs.

A pioneer in the field of oceanography for many years, Florida State is making marine studies one of its strong points of emphasis in the decade ahead. Facilities for oceanographic research are located both on the campus and in the Ed Ball Marine Laboratories on the Gulf of Mexico, south of Tallahassee.

The University's largest grouping of physical facilities for scientific reseach is to be found in its Science Complex, on the western quadrant of the campus. This Complex interconnects major units in the sciences by means of a network of arcades which provide a built-in proximity for interdisciplinary research.

Rounding out the University's research resources are two nuclear accelerators, a million-book library and special research facilities in geo-physical fluid dynamics, educational technology, molecular biophysics, social research, political research, psychobiology and psychology.
