HEAD COACH — Ken Stibler

FLORIDA STATE vs. BISCAYNE

The Seminoles close out the home slate for the early part of the season tonight against an up and coming bank of Biscayne Bobcats coached by Ken Stibler. Like almost all of Florida State's opponents this year, Biscayne figures to be "up" for tonight's game.

Biscayne is 3-2 for the season with wins over Florida Institute of Technology, Old Dominion and Florida Tech, with losses to North Carolina and LaSalle.

Leading the Bobcat scorers is 6-2 guard Bob McCloud with a 19.6 average. Center David Lawyer and forward Art Collins have 15 point averages while the remaining two starters, Ken Tarke and Rich Haas, are averaging 5.4 per game.

One of the big boosts for the Bobcats has been the play of freshman reserve Ed Zukowski. The 6-5 sub is averaging 10.6 points per game and scored 21 against Old Dominion. Lawyer and Collins lead in rebounding with 12.1 and 9.6 averages respectively.

Coach Hugh Durham's Seminoles bring a 2-0 record and number two national ranking into the game.

Ron King is in his familiar spot as the Seminoles leading scorer with a 22 point average. However, he is only one of six Seminoles in double figures. Otis Johnson is next in the scoring race at 15.5, even though he is not a starter.

Following Johnson are Lawrence McCray (14.0), Otto Petty (11.5), Reggie Royals (11.0) and Benny Clyde (10.0). Royals, McCray and Johnson lead the Seminole rebounders with 13.5, 9.5 and 7.0 averages.

Royals should reach a milestone in his Florida State career tonight. The 6-10 senior from Whiteville, N.C., needs only six points to join the exclusive 1,000 Point Club. When he does it will give the Seminoles two current members, King being the other.

Before tonight's varsity tipoff, the Athletic Department will honor the men who brought Florida State its first athletic victory. The 1947-48 basketball squad won its season opener, 39-36, over Spring Hill College 25 years ago tomorrow. The members of that squad are tonight's special guests.
