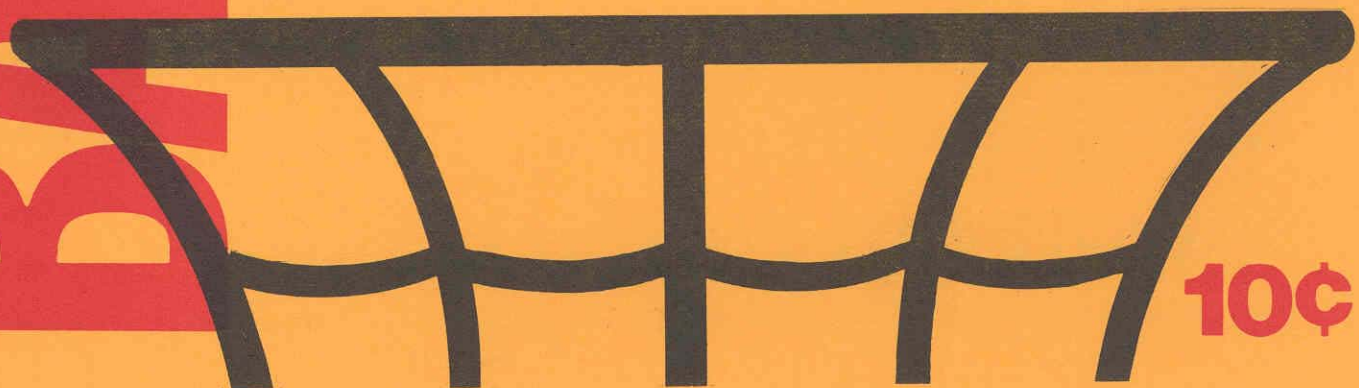

FLORIDA STATE vs. SOUTHERN ILLINOIS

The Seminoles return home for the first of two ball games. Tonight's opponent, Southern Illinois, brings an 8-9 record into Tully Gym. Monday night, Florida State entertains South Florida.

The Saluki's record is some what deceiving as six of their nine losses have been by two points or less or have been in overtime. That means there have been few games they have not been in right down to the end. The visitors will be trying to snap a four game losing streak, two of which were lost by two points and a third in overtime. Among SIU's victories is one over New Mexico State in the Road Runner Classic back in December.

The Salukis have good size. They will start Nate Hawthorne (6-4, 16.2) and Dennis Shidler (6-1, 8.5) at guard, Tim Ricci (6-3, 10.6) and George Thompson (6-7, 9.0) at forward and Joe Meriweather (6-10, 15.2) at center. Meriweather (11.9) and Thompson (6.4) are the leading rebounders.

Coach Hugh Durham will probably go with the same line-up that started the Samford game. That would have Reggie Royals and Lawrence McCray at the posts, Otis Cole and Otis Johnson on the wings and Dennis Burke at the point. Benny Clyde, who missed the Samford game after coming down with the flu, was back at practice Friday and should be able to play.

Following Monday night's game, here, the Seminoles will be playing four of their next five on the road.
