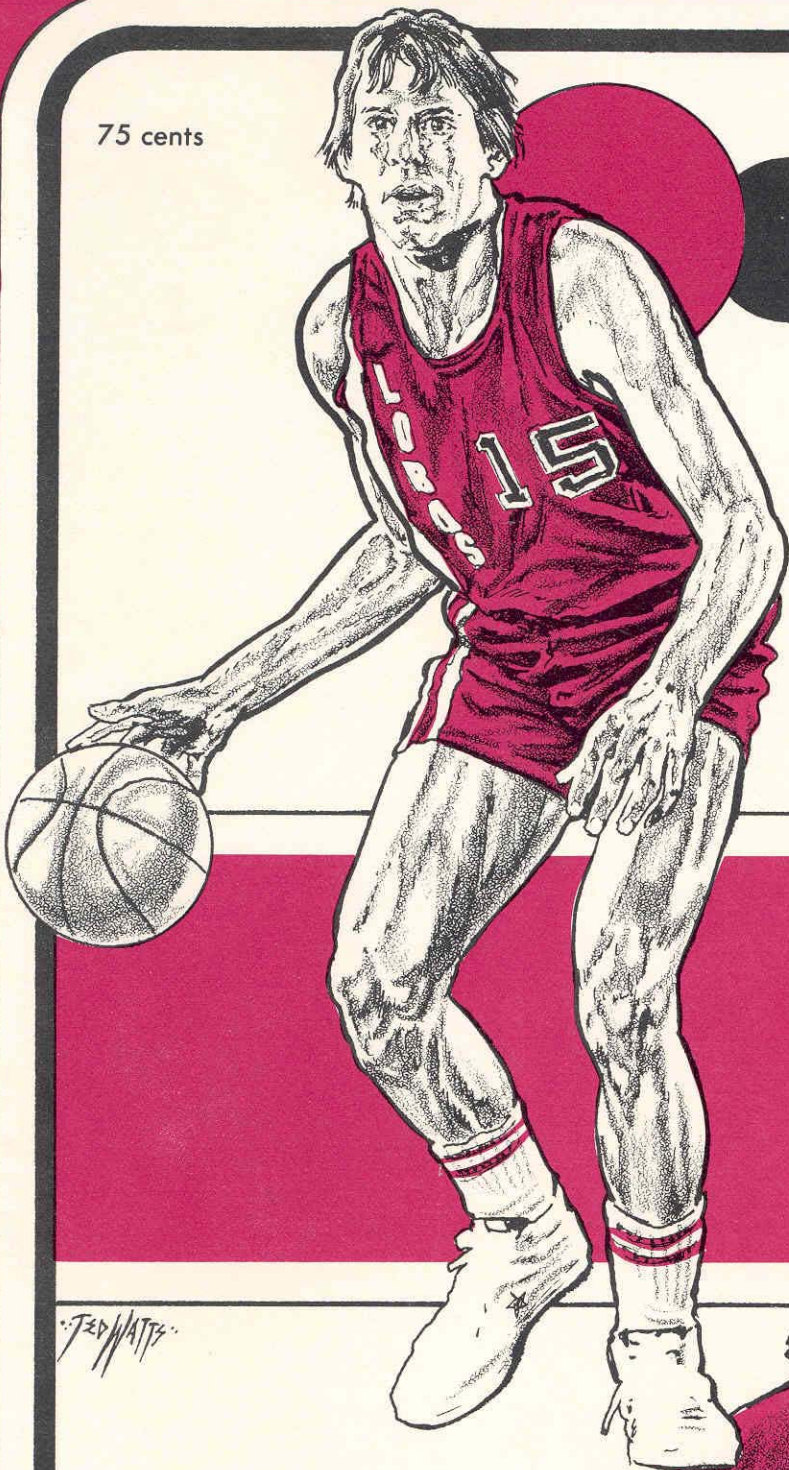

A LOOK AT THE GAME

FSU Top East Independent

Fresh off a tough weekend of Western Athletic Conference action, New Mexico tonight takes on nationally prominent Florida State University in a non-conference battle.

It is the Seminoles first trip to University Arena and only the second contest between the two schools.

Last year New Mexico journeyed to Tallahassee to take on the always tough FSU squad, but came away with a 90-71 defeat. In that contest, the FSU squad showed a strong balanced scoring attack with guard Larry Warren leading the charge. The 6-4 junior had 17 points in the contest, but hit seven of his 12 shots from the floor.

Greg Grady also chipped in to help the Seminoles roll past New Mexico as the 6-9 postman pushed through 14 points.

Florida State is off to a strong start this season, winning 11 and losing just four prior to their Saturday night contest in Buffalo, N.Y. against Canisius.

Last Tuesday night the Seminoles defeated Biscayne College of Miami, 95-85. In that game, Greg Grady was impressive, scoring 25 points and pulling down 12 rebounds. Grady hit 12 of 14 shots from the floor to accumulate the total.

In all, the Seminoles shot a red-hot 71 per cent from the floor but also suffered 26 turnovers. It was the turnovers that kept the contest close.

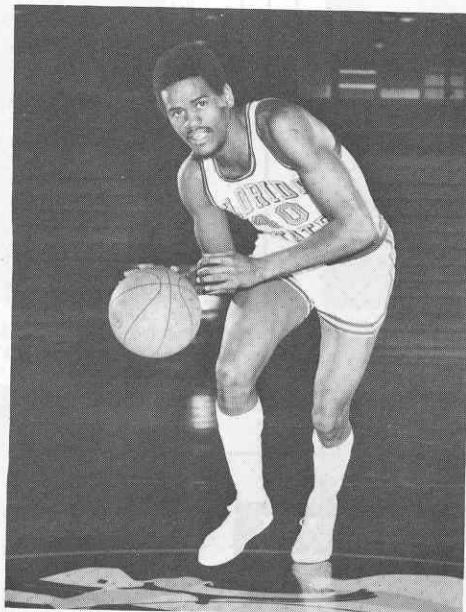
And the FSU squad has played some of the nation's top squads, too, in compiling their win-loss mark. They dropped a one point decision to Memphis State, 70-69, and fought Louisville on even terms for most of the contest before losing 84-75. They have defeated such teams as Purdue of the Big Ten and Ohio University of the Mid-America Conference.

An independent in the south, Florida State is averaging over 83 points per contest and has reached the 100 point peak three times. They defeated Eastern Kentucky 107-75, Wisconsin-Milwaukee, 104-82, and Hofstra, 107-71.

In order to handle the explosive scoring punch of the Florida Staters, the Lobos will have to clamp a strong defense and guard Pat King will be the leader there. He is the man who will draw the tough defensive assignment. Center Bill Hagins will have his hands full defensively, too,

as the 6-7 strongman will again be going against much taller men in the middle.

Hagins will also have to play well at the offensive end of the court for New Mexico as he leads the team with a 15.2 scoring average. Bill is also the leading rebounder with better than 12 boards an outing. Rich Porkorski, the second leading scorer for New Mexico at just under 14 points per game, will also be facing a size

mismatch inside. Pork is the second biggest man on the Lobo squad tonight.

Larry Warren is the leading scorer for Florida State as he is averaging almost 17 points a game. Warren has hit for over 30 points this season, counting 33 against Marshall University in a 90-63 victory in just the third game of the season.

Greg Grady is the leading rebounder for the Seminoles, pulling down over 11 a game. He is also scoring over 24 points a game and that's good for second on the squad.

Two other FSU players have hit the double figure mark with Zach Perkins hitting 12 a game and Wayne Smalls at 11.6.
