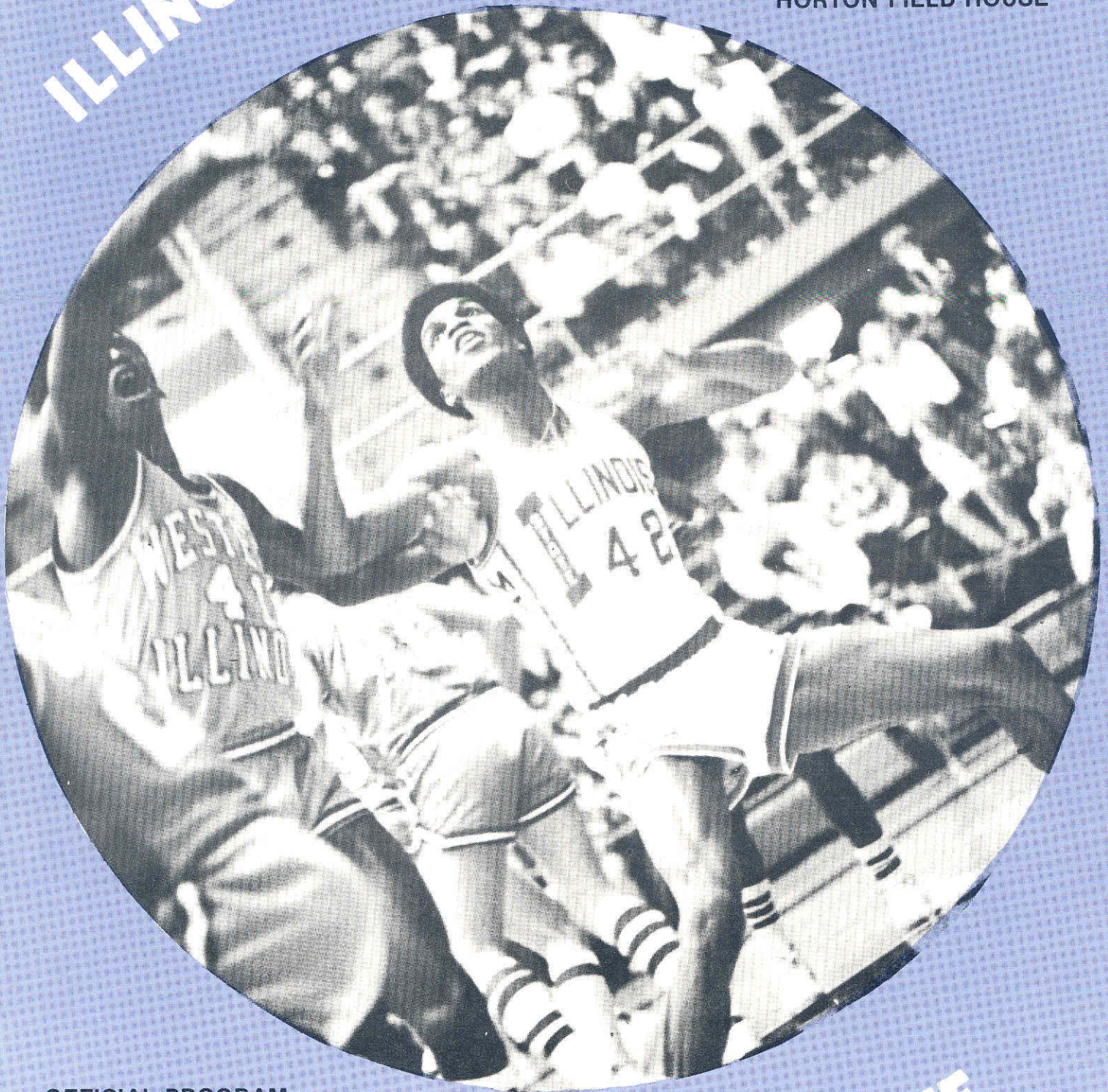

FLORIDA STATE

SEMINOLES TESTED BY TOUGH STATE

Illinois State confronts one of the strongest teams on its basketball schedule tonight when Florida State steps onto the Horton Field House hardwood.

The Seminoles entered last weekend with a 12-4 record. Their only four losses came to "Top 20" ranked teams — Indiana, Alabama, Washington and Oregon State.

Coach Hugh Durham feels his club has improved since then.

"We found out in those early games that we were not as good, at that time, as the top 10 teams," Durham said, "but we continued to improve and after a couple of changes we are playing better than we were earlier."

Florida State's more recent victims include Memphis State 100-79, Western Kentucky 88-80 and Jacksonville 77-57. The Seminoles carried a seven-game winning streak into the weekend, a streak that started after a three-point loss to Pacific-8 leader Oregon State.

Sophomore David Thompson (not the David Thompson) came off the bench to spark Florida State's scoring in recent games, but the Seminoles feature strong defense and offensive balance.

Florida State's veteran club has all seven players who saw action in the Seminoles' 72-70 victory over Illinois State in the first-ever meeting between the schools early last season. Larry Warren paced FSU with 21 points.

ISU will play at Florida State on Feb. 12.

Durham, now in his 10th season as Florida State's coach, runs one of the most successful basketball programs in the nation. He has a 181-77 record at the Tallahassee, Fla., school.

His most memorable season was in 1972, when the Seminoles had a 27-6 record and reached the NCAA Tournament finals. UCLA stopped Florida State 81-76 in the title game.

Florida State's recent graduates to enter pro basketball are Dave Cowens, Rowland Garrett, Benny Clyde and Reggie Royals.

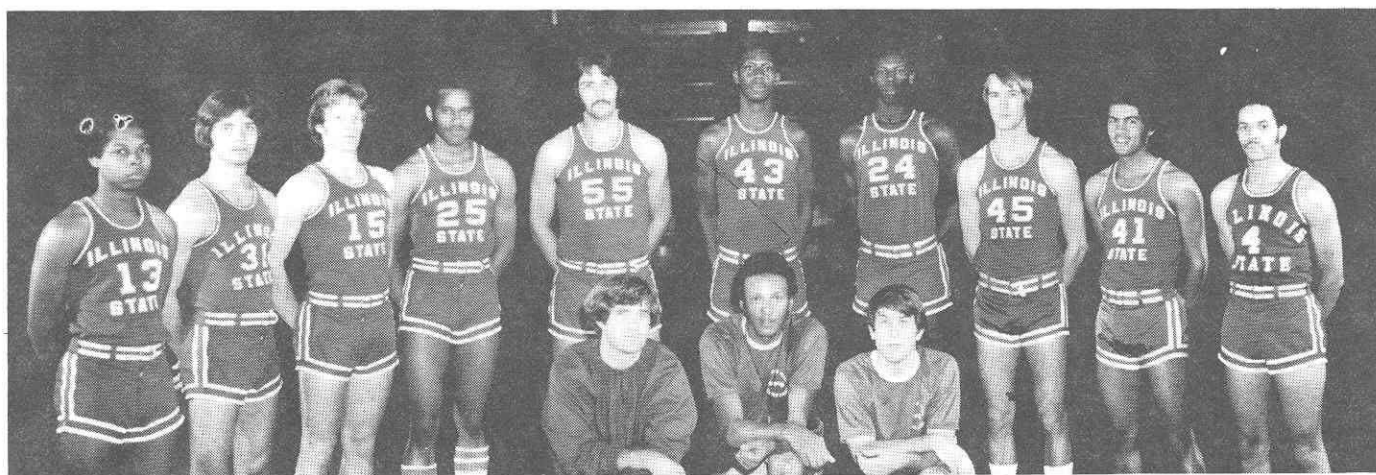
