Quotable Quotes from the Jacksonville - Florida State game

Coach Don Beasley: "I think our excellent free throw shooting throughout the game, and especially our field goal shooting in the second half won the game for us. That second half field goal performance was a big factor in our win." On that second-half technical foul: "Well, I was just trying to help him referee the game."

Coach Hugh Durham: "Jacksonville played good defense, but we missed many wide-open layups. We expected to win, but in a rivalry, anyone could win; When your guard shoots 6 for 25, and your're 11 of 20 from the FT line, you've got to lose. I'd give the credit to their defense. We're not solely responsible for our poor shooting. We shot well in practice this afternoon, but then there was nobody guarding us. As a whole, though, Jacksonville didn't give us a whole lot of easy shots."

Ricky Williams: "I knew I had to play well tonight. It was really the first time I was psychologically ready to play, something I must do more often. I couldn't get up before tonight."

Kent Glover: "It's the best game ever since I've been at JU. Everybody played 100%. I caught some cramps in both legs in the second half, but, boy, did I want to get back in the game. I hadn't been feeling too well up to tonight. But I feel we're now on our way."

James Ray: "Well, we could be on our way. But Tyler says definitely."

Tyler (Donnie): "A really big factor was the crown. It got us more excited than any time this year. And all that nonsense about JU going back to Swisher gym. There's no way that'll happen
