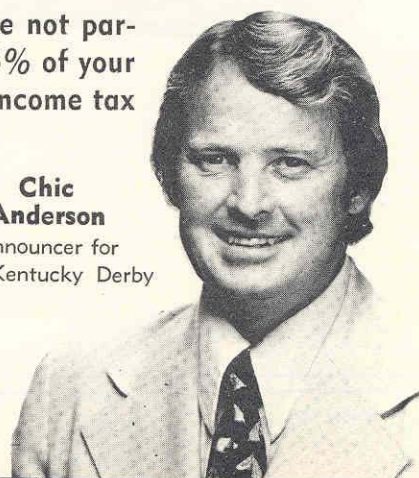

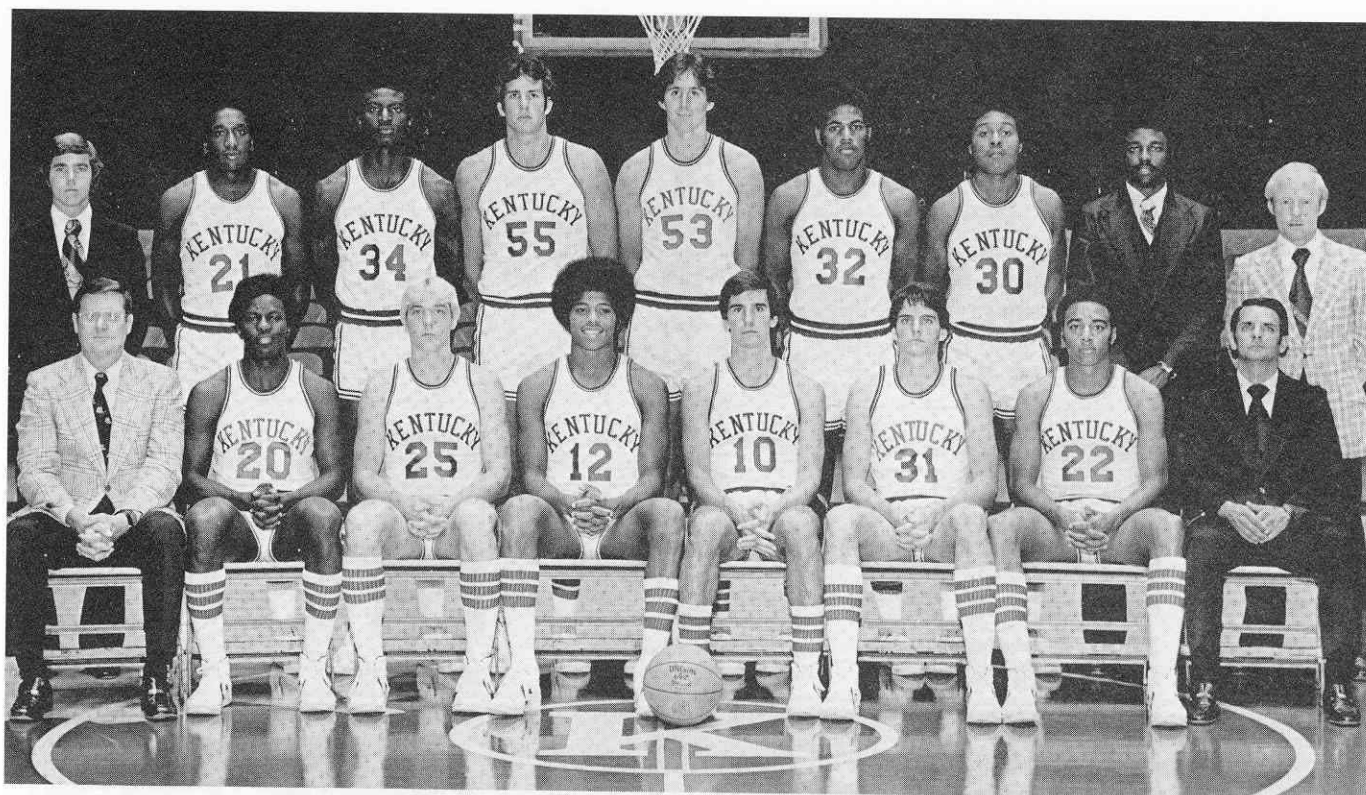

THE SERIES

UK and FSU are tied 2-2 in a series that began in 1958 with a 91-68 UK home victory. In December 1960, FSU coach Hugh Durham (then an outstanding guard) led the Seminoles to a stunning 63-58 upset over the Wildcats in Memorial Coliseum. UK assistant coach Dick Parsons was captain of that Wildcat team. UK beat FSU 83-54, again in Lexington, and then 10 years later, saw the Seminoles close out coach Adolph Rupp's career with a 73-54 defeat in the Mideast Regional finals at Dayton.

KENTUCKY WILDCATS NATIONALLY RANKED SECOND BY AP AND BASKETBALL WEEKLY, SIXTH BY UPI

The Wildcats are 16-2 overall, 9-1 SEC, 8-2 Home and 1-0 Neutral. Kentucky crushed Vanderbilt, 113-73, Saturday, in Rupp Arena, completely dominating a team that it beat by only two points a month ago. To say the Cats are back to early season form is an understatement. The key could be twofold - a return to complete team play, and Rick Robey's return to good health following some chest problems as a result of an automobile accident. Coach Joe B. Hall emphasized the team play aspect following Saturday's crusher over Vandy. The Wildcats hold a 15.2 scoring margin over opponents and an 8.1 rebounding margin. Jack Givens moved into 14th place in UK's all-time scoring column with 1,243 points behind student assistant coach Jim Andrews. Larry Johnson may be the first Wildcat to be listed in SEC assists leaders - traditionally, assists are hard to come by with UK statisticians, - but this week's SEC stats list Johnson fifth in the league with 4.4 per game.

FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY SEMINOLES UNRANKED

Florida State is 12-8 for the season. FSU coach Hugh Durham has plenty of reasons to fire up his squad against the Wildcats -- he is a native of Louisville; he has had a hand in both FSU wins; the UK game counts as a Metro Conference game for the Seminoles; a chance for a win over a nationally ranked team. FSU was beaten handily by powerful Clemson, 108-92, but lost by only six to No. 1 San Francisco, and three to Louisville. A fine shooting team, FSU was hitting over 50 per cent through 16 games. In a warmup for the Kentucky game, FSU put the coup de grace to Baptist College (S. C.) Saturday, 139-72, as the Seminoles set school records in scoring, and second half scoring (85 points). FSU hit 69 per cent in the second half as freshman Murray Brown hit 11-12 and led scoring with 27 points.

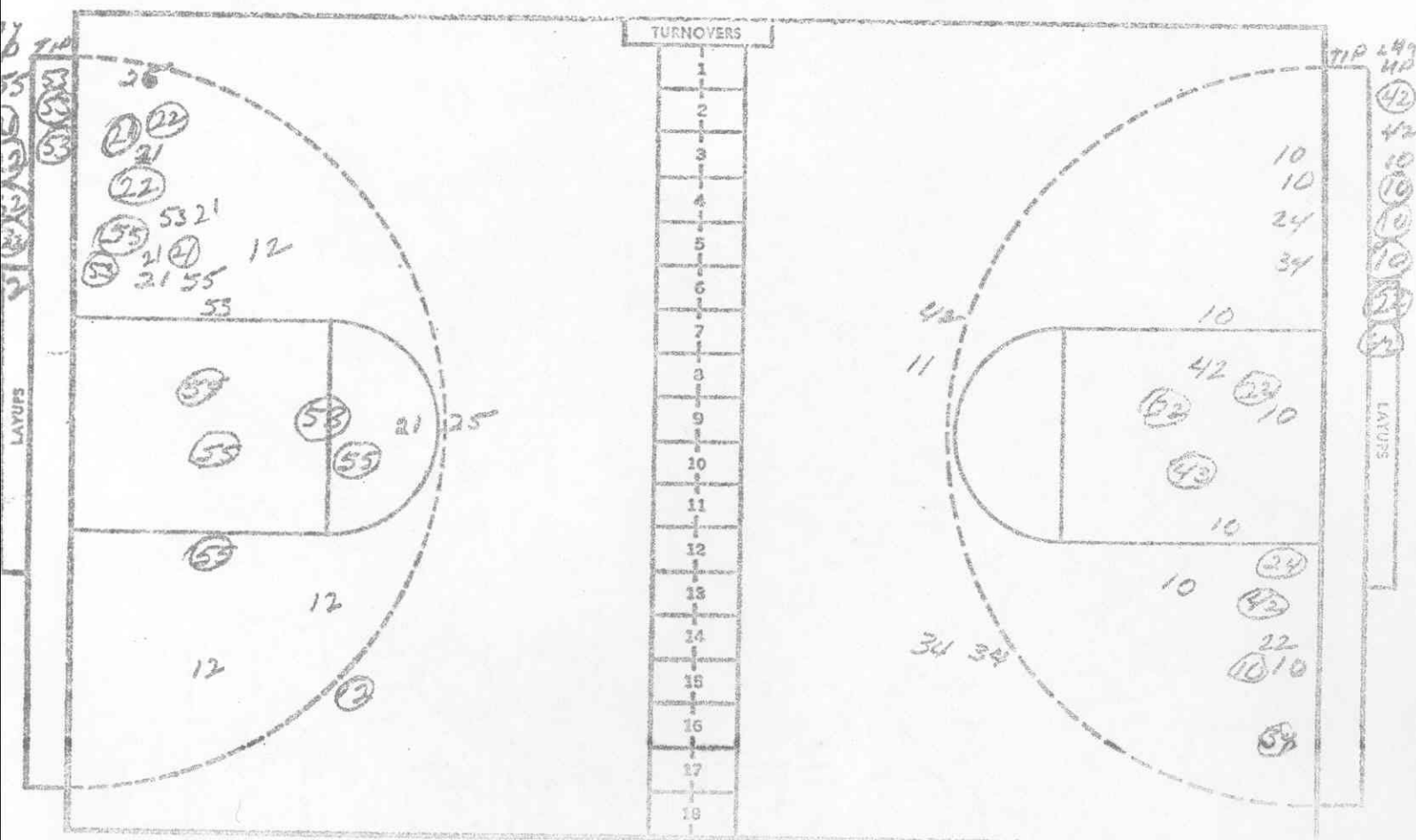
