

Florida State vs. Troy State

seminole basketball

With the opening game under its belt, Florida State hopes to put its jitters aside as the Seminoles tangle with visiting Troy State tonight in Tully Gym.

Senior forward Harry Davis pumped in 23 points and hauled down 15 rebounds as FSU cruised to an 83-59 opening game win over Rollins last Monday night. Although hampered by mistakes throughout most of the game, the outcome of the intra-state match-up was never in doubt after the first three minutes. The Seminoles fell behind 4-2, but then reeled off nine consecutive points to go ahead, 11-4. Still, Rollins kept the game close and trailed by a nine-point margin, 36-27, at the half.

"It was a typical first game," says head coach Hugh Durham. "We've got a lot of problems that need to be ironed out before the Troy State game.

"But against Rollins we had a chance to play against someone other than ourselves. And after 40 consecutive days of practicing against only ourselves, the fellows needed to see some new faces."

Davis's 23 points provided the bulk of the offensive show for the Seminoles. He made eight of 14 floor shots and seven of nine tosses from the charity strip. Also hitting in twin figures for FSU were senior guard Eugene Harris (14) and sophomore forward Murray Brown (10), who came off the bench.

Seminole fans were watching all familiar faces in the opening contest. Durham used 10 players eight dented the scoring column—and with the exception of Harris, who was red-shirted last season, all were on the '76 roster.

Durham says he will still be looking for the best playing combinations in the early games of the 1977–78 season. He plans to start Davis and Hank Mann at the forward slots, Kris Anderson at center, and Tony Jackson and Eugene Harris at guards again tonight. Mickey Dillard will come off the bench early to fill in at a back court position.

Troy State opened its season on a sour note last Monday with a 80-53 loss to Austin Peay.

The Trojans had four players score in double figures but with a 33.3 field goal percentage coach Wes Bizilia's team was never in the game. Senior forward Marvin Sales paced the Trojans with 13 points and 11 rebounds while 6-1 guard Terry Baker tallied 11 and 6-4 guard Paul Bussman 10. Reserve guard Bryan Cruce came off the bench to add 10.

Troy State will start 6-4 Murphy Brown and Sales at forwards, 6-6 Jim Means at center and Baker and Bussman at guards.

Tonight's game will be the second of nine consecutive road games for the Trojans. Troy State finished the 1977 season with a 15-14 record (11-5 in conference play), tying North Alabama for the Gulf South Conference crown. But too many key losses from that team, which also lost to North Alabama in the championship game of the Division II South Central Regional game, to have its hopes too high this season.

- THE OFFICIALS: Dick Pace (Maitland, Fla.) and Morris Middleton (Orlando, Fla.), both assigned by the Metro Conference.
- THE PAST GAMES: Florida State opened its season Monday with an 83-58 victory over Rollins Monday. That was the same night Troy State was losing a 80-53 verdict at Austin Peay. Last night (Wednesday), the Trojans bowed 84-69 to Georgia Tech, a fellow member with FSU in the Metro Conference.
- THE SERIES: Florida State has a 7-1 series advantage dating back to the first game in 1947-48. The only Troy State victory came in that '47-48 season when the Trojans captured a 49-48 verdict on their home floor. In the most recent outing last season here in Tully, the Seminoles captured an 83-69 verdict.
- NO TV--Unlike previous years, there will be no television replay of tonight's game in the Tallahassee area. In fact, none of the FSU home games this season will be re-telecast by local stations.
- AROUND THE METRO--Metro conference teams are off to a 7-2 start this season. Leading the way is Georgia Tech at 3-0. Also unbeaten are Memphis State (2-0), Florida State (1-0) and Cincinnati (1-0). Still looking for the first win are St. Louis (0-1) and Louisville (0-1). Yet to play its first game is Tulane(0-0).
- METRO TONIGHT--There will be three other games tonight involving Metro Conference teams. St. Louis travels to Indiana State, Southern Mississippi is at Memphis State and Cincinnati hosts North Carolina A & T.
- METRO FRIDAY--Only one game scheduled. That finds St. Louis playing at Missouri-St. Louis.
- METRO SATURDAY--Games involving Metro teams Saturday find Tulane at Mississippi, Vanderbilt at Louisville, Biscayne at Cincinnati, Georgia State at Georgia Tech and Northeast Louisiana at Memphis State.
- NEXT FOR FLORIDA STATE--The Seminoles will return to the floor when they host St. Leo Monday at 8:05 p.m. After that the Garnet and Gold plays in the Big Sun Tournament at St. Petersburg, Dec. 9-10, and the Vulcan Classic in Birmingham, Dec. 16-17.
