



Florida State vs. St. Leo

seminale basketball

A year ago the Seminoles were loaded with youngsters. When coach Hugh Durham looked down the bench for his first substitute he knew he would spot the opposition a mismatch in experience on the floor.

But Durham suffered through the growing pains, even though they were costly at times, and as a result fields a team with a head start on the future in tonight's

game with St. Leo in Tully Gym.

Center Kris Anderson, forward Murray Brown and guards Tony Jackson and Mickey Dillard wasted little time finding their ways from poised, veteran high school players to the real, rough world of college basketball. During the 1976–77 cage season they played in no fewer than 18 of the Seminoles' 27 contests.

Anderson and Jackson appear to be the first two ready for this type of action as they have earned starting positions for Florida State when the season

opened last week.

"Kris is a player I would compare with Reggie Royals (the 6-10 center who helped FSU into the 1972 national championship game)," says Durham. "He handles the ball well, hands out numerous assists and is an excellent player at the 15-foot range. But scoring isn't his role right now. We're more interested in him getting the ball to the open man and rebounding.

"Having Kris in the lineup also gives us a chance to use Harry Davis in a new spot which will give us additional strength across the front line." Davis, Florida State's 6-7 muscleman, was moved out to the wings where he will be most useful to the Tribe.

Anderson began his college career at the tender age of 17 and is still only 18 years old. Unable to vote, he was still old enough to get his playing experience against some of the top centers in the country. He was matched up with 7-1 Tree Rollins of Clemson and 7-0 Bill Cartwright of San Francisco at various times last season.

Jackson has taken over as the Seminoles' Carlton Byrd as the team's playmaker. Jackson won't be expected to score a lot of points—he averaged only 1.4 last year—but look for him to deal out plenty of assists.

"Tony has an uncanny knack of finding the open man," says Durham. "If he can get the ball off to someone who is open we aren't going to worry about

how many points Tony is scoring."

Like other Florida State guards, Eugene Harris and Dillard, he has the quickness to apply plenty of pressure on the opposition as they bring the ball upcourt. Jackson is different than most players in college basketball today—he enjoys a good defensive challenge.

Dillard and Brown are also figured heavily into the

Florida State picture this season.

Dillard's chief assset is his quickness which gives Durham the confidence to press. He played in 25 games last season, averaging 14 minutes of playing time, scoring 5.8 points a game including 19 against Kentucky.

Brown, at 6-7, 190 pounds, is probably one of the Tribe's most physical players, second only to Davis. Early last season he saw very little playing time as he adjusted to the new complicated offensive and defensive systems. But as the season wore on he came off the bench with more frequency and finished the campaign playing in 18 games.

Brown will see action in much the same capacity he did last season, as a back-up at forward and center. In FSU's opener against Rollins, he came off the bench and pumped in 10 points while playing only 18

minutes.

"We expect to see a lot of both Murray and Mickey this season," says Durham. "They seem to have adjusted to our style now after the normal freshman frustrations.

"Murray, at the moment, is scheduled for a back-up role but Mickey has the potential to move into the starting five at any time."
