Florida State vs. Cincinnati

Home courts have their advantages.

Cincinnati has its Riverfront Coliseum, Kentucky has Rupp Arena, UCLA has Pauley Pavilion and Florida State has Tully Gym.

And what's it like playing in Tully Gym, a 24-year-old, 3,500 seat structure located in the heart of the Florida State campus. Well, Bill Skutt wrote in the Metro News, "When the Seminoles start running, the drums start beating, the fans start screaming, the thermometer starts climbing. The world could come to an end but the crowd at a Florida State basketball game wouldn't find out until the final horn sounded."

Cincinnati, rated as the preseason favorite in the Metro Conference, will have an opportunity to experience playing in Tully Gym tonight as the Seminoles host the Bearcats in their third conference game of the season.

Revenge will be the topic of conversation for tonight's Metro game. FSU will be seeking to turnaround the results for the first meeting of the two schools earlier this season. Steve Collier's controversial 25-foot jumper at the buzzer gave Cincinnati a 77-75 win over the Tribe.

The Seminoles have run up an impressive record at Tully Gym during the past six years and FSU will attempt to extend it one more tonight. Hugh Durham's teams have won 67 games while losing only five.

But Cincinnati knows what home court advantages are all about. The Bearcats had a string of 69 consecutive wins in Cincinnati before the record was broken recently by Louisville.

Coaches always dislike playing on the road because the crowds are almost totally against them. "Crowds play a big role in a game," any coach will say. "They can be intimidating factors to any team."

Florida State enters the game with senior forward Harry Davis scoring just over 20 points a game. Mickey Dillard, David Thompson and Eugene Harris are also scoring in double figures. The Seminoles owned an 11-2 record prior to Saturday's game with Tulane.

Cincinnati, with a 9-3 record before last Saturday's game at Memphis State, is led by forward Pat Cummings with 17.4 points a game while center Bob Miller is averaging 14.1 points and 10.1 rebounds. Eddie Lee will start at the other forward position while Steve Collier and Bobby Sherlock will get the nods at guard.

Florida State plays on the road this weekend, visiting the unfriendly confines of Louisville's Freedom Hall for a Sunday afternoon game.

Another Metro Conference opponent, St. Louis, will meet the Seminoles on January 26 in their next home game at home-sweet-home Tully Gym.
