## ***seminole basketball***

### **Florida State vs. Georgia Tech**

For the four seniors on the Florida State basketball roster, tonight's Metro Conference encounter with Georgia Tech marks the conclusion of their collegiate careers before a Seminole crowd.

Harry Davis, Eugene Harris, Davis Thompson and James Smith will suit up for the final time in Tully Gym. But each of them have made important contributions to the Florida State efforts over the years.

Davis, who has played in all but one game since he came to FSU, has his name dotted throughout the Seminole record book. His most notable accomplishments are a fourth place position in the all-time career scoring list (1,421 points to date) and, with only four more games needed, will take the top slot for most games played in a Garnet and Gold uniform. He has a career scoring average of 13.9 going into tonight's contest.

Harris had been a spot starter most of his career but took over the "big" guard position this season. He is averaging 12.0 a game this season and maintains a 8.7 career average.

Thompson came to Florida State three years ago from Lake City Junior College and has played in every game since. He is one of 14 players to join FSU's 1,000 point club, ranking eighth with 1,193 points. Averaging 13.2 points through 23 games this season,

Thompson's career clip is 15.7 per outing.

Smith transferred to Florida State after spending his freshman season at North Carolina and quickly fit into the Seminole basketball scene. FSU coach Hugh Durham refers to Smith as "my coach on the floor." He has played in 66 games at both forward and guard positions and has a 4.2 career scoring average.

Also retiring after the 1977-78 campaign is manager Jim Towey who will graduate this spring. Towey has been with the Florida State basketball team for four seasons. Towey has been a big asset to Durham, the assistant coaches and players while the Seminoles have traveled from coast to coast.

FSU

Florida State locked up a portion of the Metro Conference regular-season title with last Friday's win over Louisville. The Tribe owns a 9-1 conference mark and Memphis State's win over Georgia Tech on Saturday afternoon assured FSU the top seeding in the league tournament.

A win over Georgia Tech tonight will give the Seminoles sole possession of first place during the regular season. Either, but not both, Louisville or Memphis State, both 7-3 in conference play, could wind up with identical records as Florida State but FSU swept the two-game regular season series from both teams.
