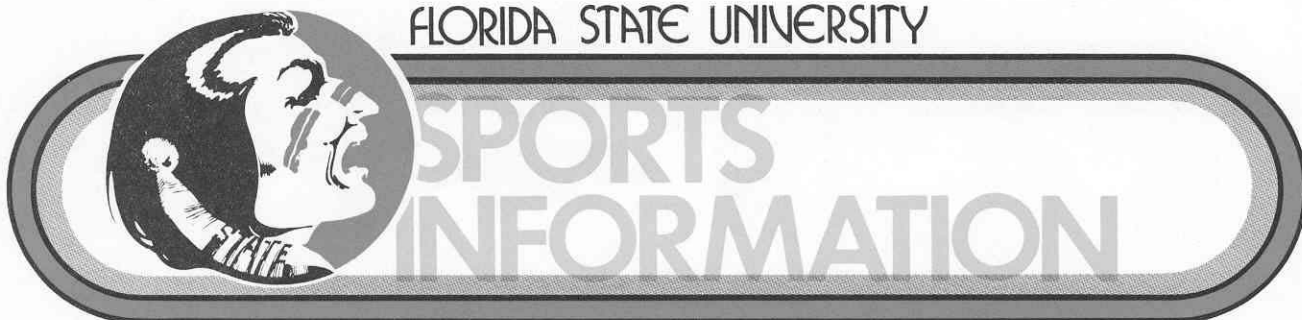

FLORIDA STATE (1-0) vs. WESTERN KENTUCKY (1-1)

Tully Gymnasium

Thursday, November 30, 1978

THE TEAMS--Florida State (1-0), a member of the Metro Conference, opened its season Monday with a 116-71 victory over Eckerd. Ohio Valley Conference member Western Kentucky enters Tully with a 1-1 record. The Hilltoppers lost their opener, 78-53, to No. 1 ranked Duke. In the home opener last Monday, Western scored a 71-59 victory over Jacksonville (Ala.) State.

THE COACHES--Seminole mentor Joe Williams and Western Kentucky's Gene Keady are each in their first seasons as head coaches at their respective institutions. Williams came to FSU from Furman and also had previous head coaching experience at Jacksonville. In 14 previous seasons as a head coach he had compiled a 234-148 record. This is the first head coaching assignment at the collegiate level for Keady.

THE OFFICIALS--The Metro Conference has assigned two officials and the Ohio Valley one for tonight's game. Representing the Metro are Bob Hartsfield (Atlanta, Ga.) and Dale Kelley (Huntingdon, Tn.) while Frank Sims (Louisville, Ky.) is the OVC representative.

THE SERIES--This is the fourth meeting between FSU and Western Kentucky. The series dates back to 1973-74 and the Seminoles enjoy a 3-0 advantage. Previous scores: 1973-74 (107-87), 1975-76 (88-80) and 1976-77 (93-73). Overall, the Seminoles are averaging 96.0 per contest compared to Western Kentucky's 80.0.

AROUND THE LEAGUE--Entering tonight's play, Metro Conference teams have compiled a 10-1 cumulative record. Louisville (2-1) sustained the only loss when it was beaten by North Carolina State in the finals of the Seawolf Classic in Anchorage, Alaska. Teams with 2-0 records include St. Louis, Virginia Tech, and Tulane. Memphis State joins Florida State at 1-0. Cincinnati, which plays an exhibition tonight with Athletes in Action, opens its regular season Saturday at Long Beach State.
