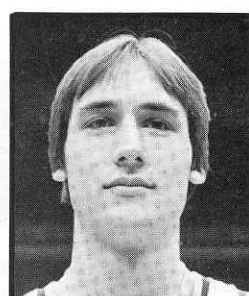
PENN STATE — EDELMAN

## PENN STATE

Penn State coach Dick Harter must really like Dayton at Christmas time. Last year he was coach at Oregon, who finished third in last season's UDIT. Now he's back for the tournament, but with the Penn State Nittany Lions. Who knows who he'll bring next year.

Actually Harter is at Penn State because he has gained a reputation for reviving basketball programs, first at Penn, then at Oregon, now, hopefully at Penn State.

The Nittany Lions were 2-7 at press time, with one game with Colgate to be played during the week. Penn State usually plays 10 or 11 men during a game with guard Mike Edelman (6-2, 15.1) leading the team in scoring. Forwards Steve Kuhn (6-7, 12.3) and Mike Owens (6-6), guard Jim Solic (6-3) and either Gary Korkowski (6-8) or Carvin Jefferson at center round out the starting line up. Three of them, Edelman, Solic and Owens are freshmen.

## TULANE

It has been almost two weeks since Tulane played a basketball game. Coach Roy Danforth hopes that the 13 days off from competition will help break a four game losing streak that his team carries into the UDIT. After two opening wins over Roosevelt and SMU, the Green Wave has dropped games to Illinois, LSU (twice), and Penn.

Tulane has good height and balanced scoring. Forward Carlos Zuniga (6-5, 12.8) leads the Green Wave in scoring and freshman center Micah Blunt (6-9, 12.2) is the leading rebounder. Zuniga's running mate Bobby Jones (6-7, 11.0) and guard Joe Holston (6-4, 10.2) complete the Tulane starters in doubles. 6-5 guard Marc Fletcher is the only senior starter.

## FLORIDA STATE

The Florida State Seminoles boasted one of the "quickest guard combinations in the country" in junior co-captains Tony Jackson and Mickey Dillard. Unfortun-

nately, for new coach Joe Williams, he lost Dillard after the second game of the year when he broke his leg in practice. On top of that the Seminoles have little height and experience this year, with only one player having three years of experience and only two standing over 6-6.

Feeling sorry for them? Don't! The Seminoles are undefeated, with a 4-0 record at press time. FSU has one game this week against Florida Southern. Murray Brown (6-7, 23.4) leads the team in scoring and rebounding from the center spot. At the guards, Ed Chatman (6-3, 12.8) and Jackson (6-2) will probably start, as will forwards Jim Bozeman (6-5) and Hank Mann (6-5).

This is Florida State's second appearance in the University of Dayton Invitational Tournament. The Seminoles lost in the first round of the inaugural UDIT in 1972 to eventual champion Alabama 74-68, and won in the consolation round over Northwestern 91-73.

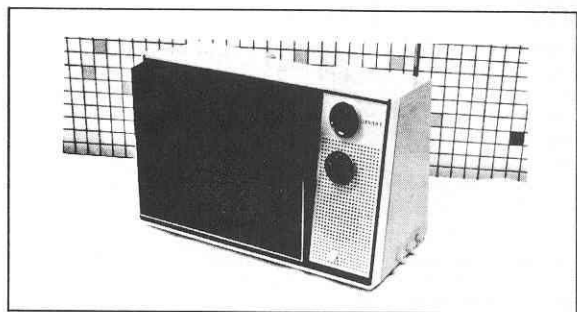
## DAYTON

The UD Flyers are riding the crest of a three game winning streak, with wins over Cal Poly, Miami and Baldwin Wallace. Dayton escaped with the win against Baldwin Wallace last Saturday night. The Flyers were down 73-70 with 26 seconds remaining. Jim Paxson sank a long jumper with 0:17 left and then Dan Bockhorn and Jack Zimmerman trapped the Yellow Jacket guard. Jim Paxson picked off a hurried Baldwin Wallace pass and took it in for the winner.

Paxson (6-6, 23.0) has done it all for the past four years at Dayton. The pre-season All-American selection is leading the 5-2 Flyers in scoring, assists and eight other categories. Other starters for Dayton are Jack Zimmerman (6-2, 12.3) with Paxson at guard, freshman sensation Mike Kanieski (6-10, 12.3) and Dave Abel (6-7) at the forwards, and Richard Montague (6-9) at center.

UD has won the UDIT twice, first in 1973 and again last year. Jim Paxson was named to the All Tournament team and earned the Whitey Gillaugh Memorial Most Valuable Player Trophy last year.
