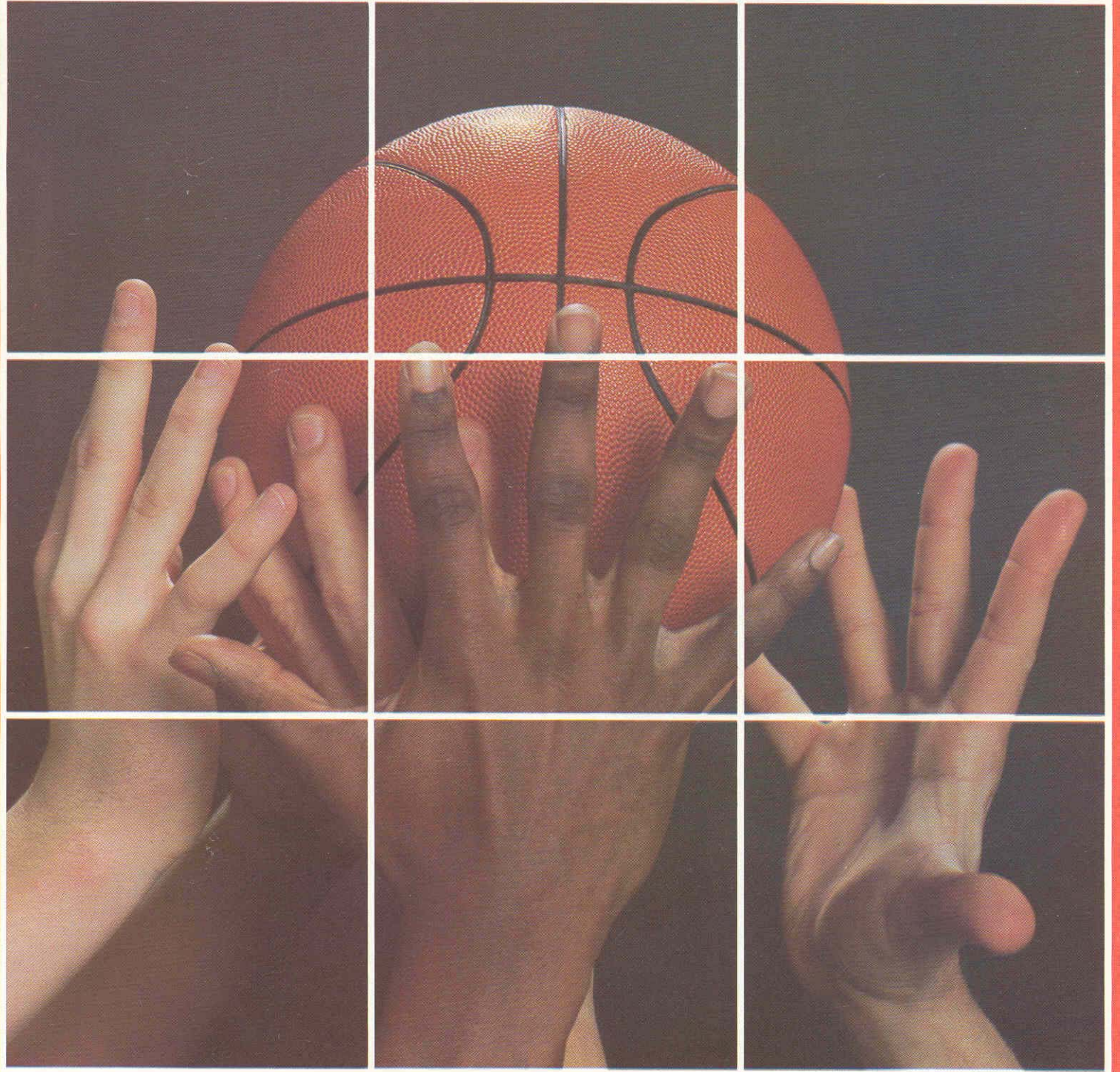

JOE WILLIAMS, Florida State University

"I'm not sure exactly what happened in the first half. We were seven out of 19 from the free throw line at one time and were only down by seven. But on offense we stopped doing anything at all . . . we played a lot of one-on-one and didn't play like we're capable."

"Had we been able to maintain the 7-11 point margin of deficit in the first half, we might've had a shot. It was a blow when we had to take Tony Jackson out in the first half when he got in foul trouble. After he went out, we didn't handle the trap very well and took ourselves out of the game."

"Kentucky is a great team. But I don't think they had too much to do with us shooting 7 for 11, ~~misses~~ from the line during that stretch in the first half."

JOE HALL, University of Kentucky

"It was not one of our finesse games. However, we shot 42% from the field but still had a 22 point lead at the half . . . so we must have been doing some things ~~about~~ right. We especially did well on the boards and on defense in the first half."

"The key to our strategy was to try to stop the fast break. Minniefield was on Dillard and they didn't get a run-out the whole first half."

"Florida State is a good team. I thought Brown and Rolle caused us a good deal of problems."

"Yes, there were a lot of fouls called. But I thought the referees called a good game and called it close . . . they kept it under control."

"I was extremely surprised that we dominated the boards as we did in the first half. The difference in the first half score was definitely on the boards in that it gave us several more possessions than they had."

"We played 'live' today, after the layoff. We appeared ready to go."

"We will be looking forward to the game against Duke. Of course they beat us earlier in the season so we may have the revenge factor with us . . . we're certainly expecting a close game."
