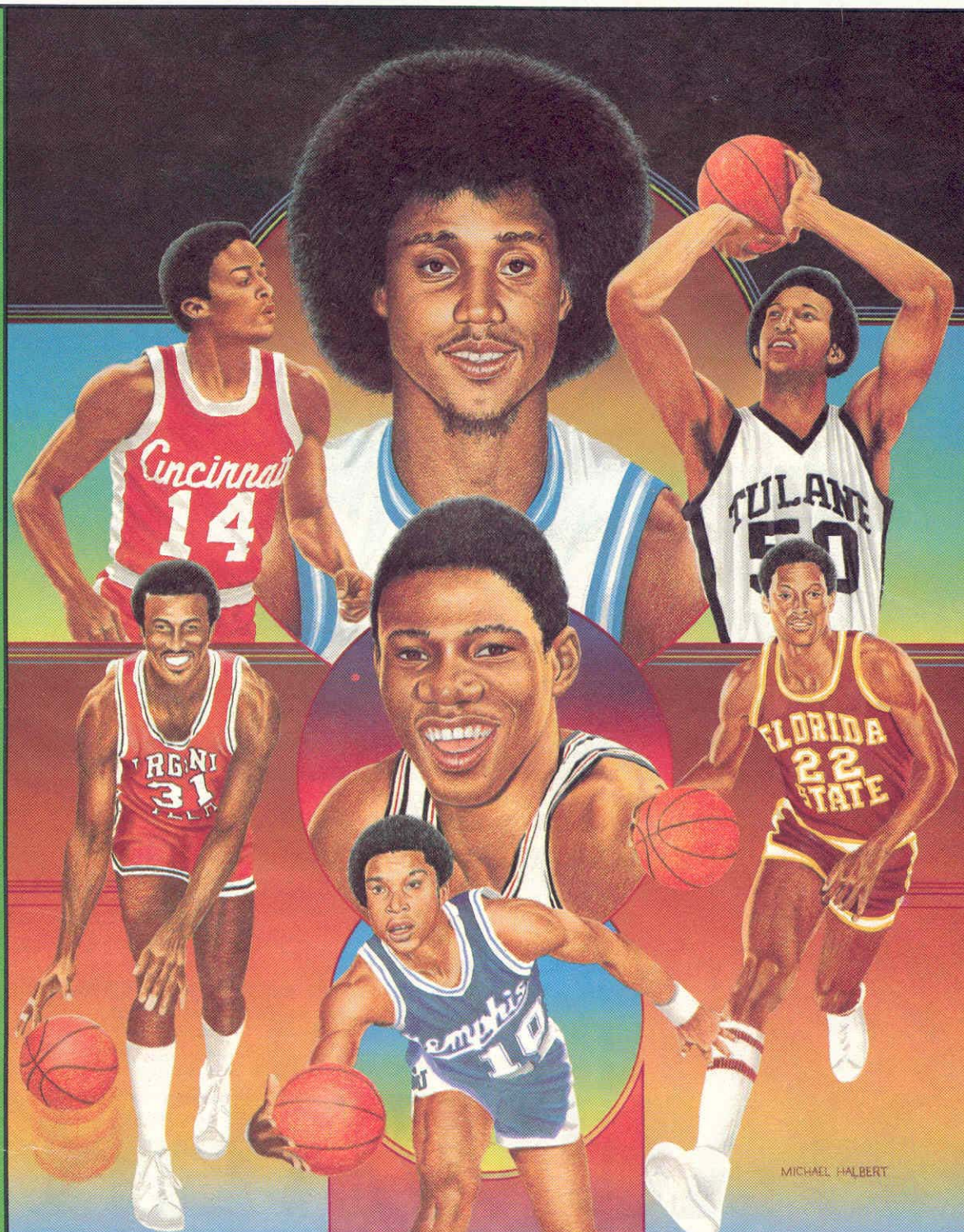


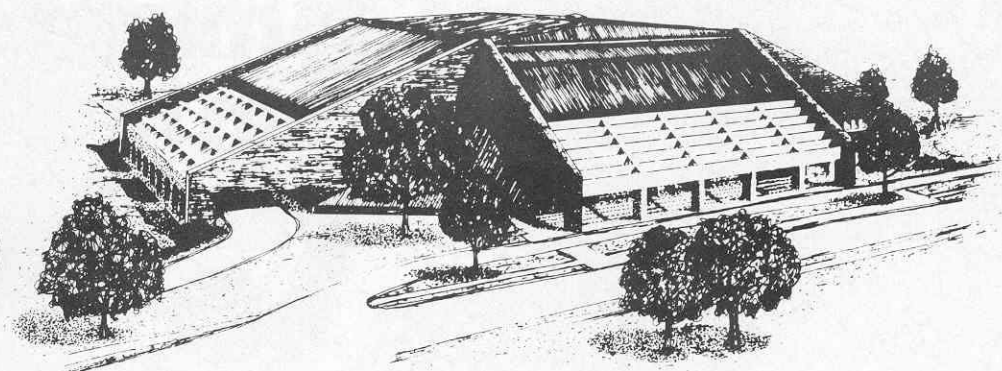

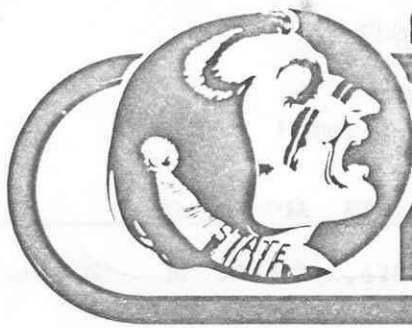

THE GAME--Following an 80-78 loss to South Carolina in Miami, Florida State attempts to get back on the winning track against the Memphis State Tigers. Prior to the South Carolina loss, FSU had captured the Cotton States Classic with wins over Missouri (68-64) and Georgia (64-62). The Tigers enter today's game with a 69-64 win over Ole Miss in a game played Tuesday. After an opening season loss to Southern Illinois (69-67), MSU has captured seven of its last eight. The only other defeat was a 111-96 verdict to Vanderbilt.

THE LAST MEETING--People in Tallahassee are still talking about the last time these two teams meet in Tully Gym. With 15:40 remaining in the second half and Florida State leading 55-54 on the strength of Mickey Dillard's two free throws, MSU coach Dana Kirk ordered his club off the court and the game was declared a forfeit and an FSU win. In a more classic game, the Seminoles sweep the season series defeating the Tigers 74-69 in the initial game of the home and home series. Overall, Florida State holds a 14-12 series edge.

THE COACHES--The Tribe is led by third year mentor Joe Williams (SMU'56) who has a 279-171 record in 16 plus years of coaching. With the Seminoles, Williams is 45-23 in his third season. Williams' previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1964-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 142-87). Williams is one of two coaches to take three separate teams to the NCAA playoffs. Kirk, in his second season at the Tiger helm, boasts a 152-94 career mark with previous coaching positions at Virginia Commonwealth (three years) and Tampa (five years). In his second year, Kirk is 20-16 at MSU.

OFF THE BENCH--Look for the Seminoles to call for Oren Gilmore (6-9, Fr. 3.9/3.5) or Pernell Tookes (6-6, Jr. 4.6/2.3) while the Tigers will bring in Phillip Haynes (6-3, Fr. 15.1/2.7). Note Haynes is the leading Tiger scorer playing in the sixth man role.

JUST WONDERING?--A few interesting facts: Today will mark only Gipson's second start. Garry Taylor had previously started at forward...Jackson leads the Tigers with 51 assists in nine games...high for the Tribe is Dillard with 27...with Dillard's 28 point effort against South Carolina, Mickey ties Ron King for ninth on the all-time Seminole point total (1352). The leader is Jim Oler (1952-56) with 1820 points...Dillard is also tied with Ham Wernke (1951-55) for ninth place on field goals made (508)...Today's contest is Dillard's 96, only four away from 100 career games as a Seminole.

THE METRO--The Florida State-Memphis State contest is the first Metro game of the year for league schools. Last season the Tribe finished third in the regular season (7-5), while the Tigers followed in fourth (5-7).

METRO AND TV--Since it is the first league game, it is naturally the first Metro television game. Ron Jacober will provide the play-by-play, while former NBA star Oscar Robertson will supply the expert commentary. The game will be carried by 11 stations ranging from Detroit to Ft. Meyers. The game will be carried locally on WECA (Channel 27) beginning at 1:20 p.m.

NEXT--The Seminoles journey to Cincinnati Monday to continue their league schedule, while the Tigers return home to face Kansas on Tuesday (Jan. 6).

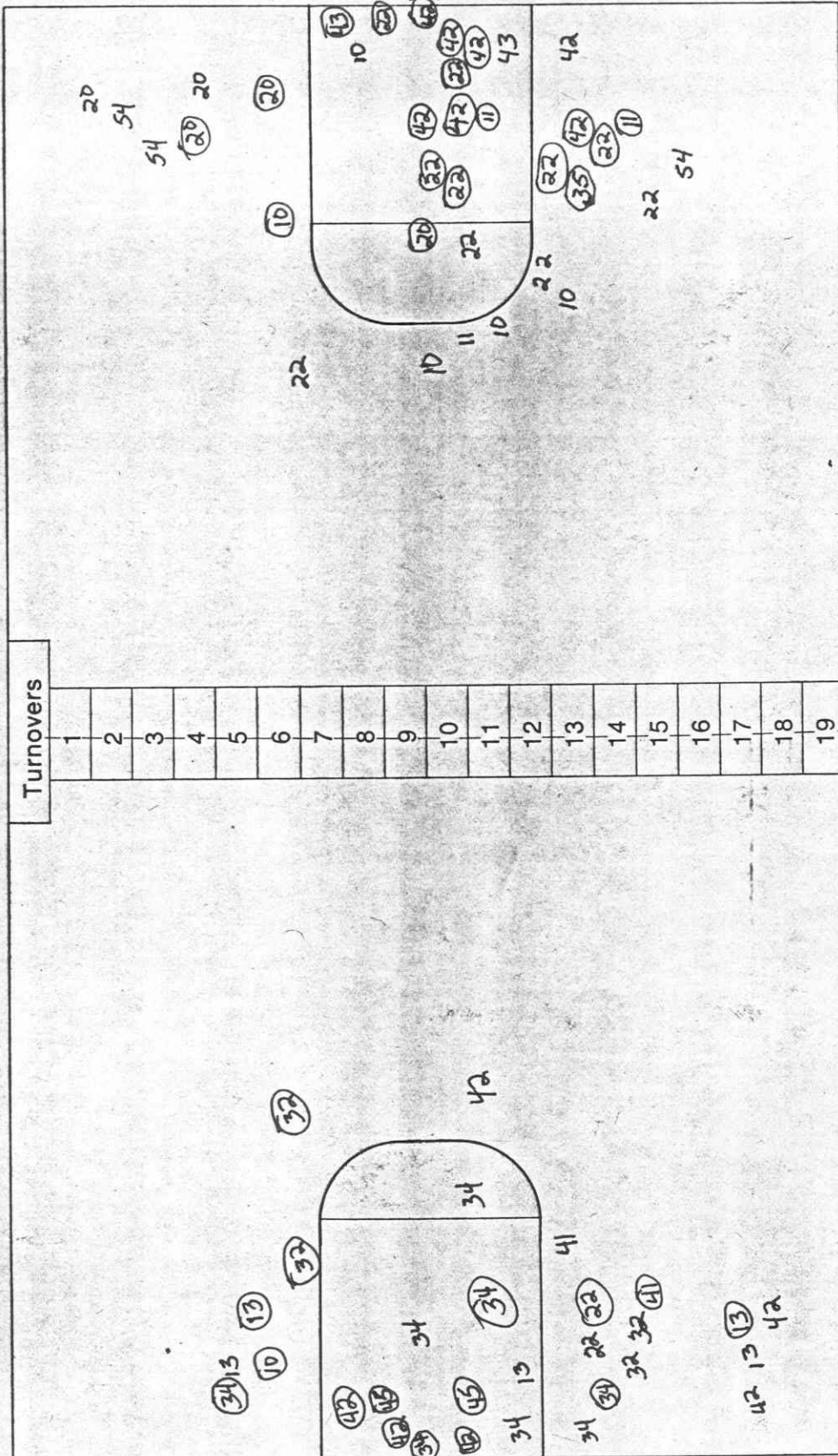

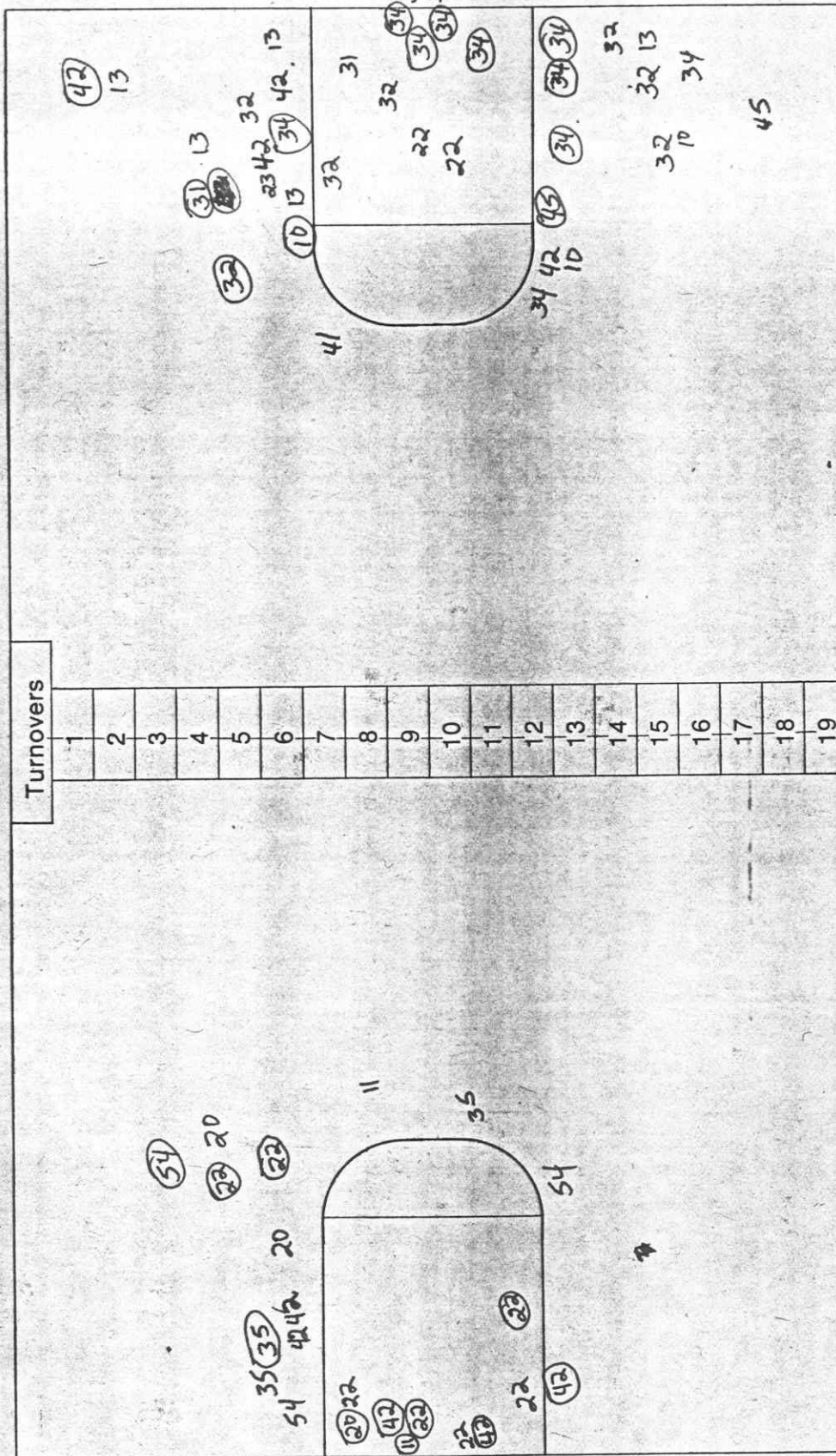
BASKETBALL SHOT CHART
