

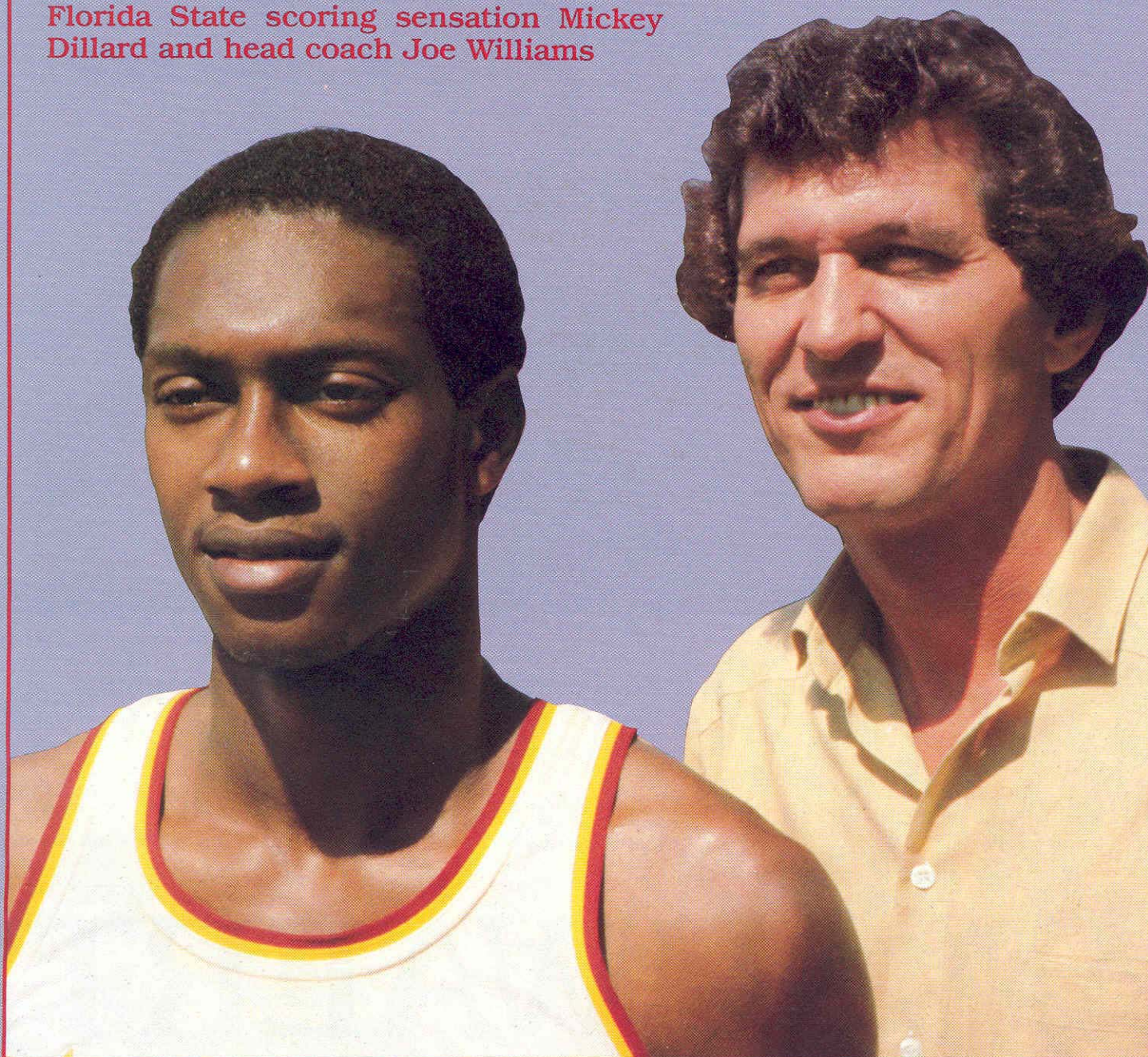

Louisville Shoots For Third Straight Win Against Metro Foe Florida State



Believe it or not, the Louisville Cardinals are home tonight to host the Seminoles of Florida State in a Metro Conference showdown. This is only the fourth home game of the year for the Cardinals and the first in nearly a month.

After a 1-6 start, Louisville has rebounded to win three of the last four ball games, improving its record to 4-7. Included in that streak are Metro victories over Tulane, 73-53, and Cincinnati, 83-68.

Florida State was 7-4 going into a Monday night game at Virginia Tech. At the time the Seminoles owned a 2-0 Metro mark with victories over Memphis State and Cincinnati.

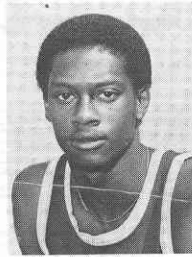
Louisville leads the series with Florida State 11-3. The Cardinals scored a one point victory over the Seminoles in Freedom Hall December 16, 1968 by a score of 79-78. Florida State's first win over the Cards came the following year in Tallahassee.

Since the Metro Conference was formed, Louisville leads the series 7-2. It has won the last six meetings in a row.

Louisville has beaten Florida State twice in finals of the Metro Tournament. In 1978 at Cincinnati, Louisville defeated Florida State 94-93 when Roger Burkman hit an 18 foot jump shot from the base line with 0:02 left on the clock. That year the Seminoles won the Metro's regular season championship and defeated Louisville twice

in the regular season.

Last year the Cards knocked off the Seminoles 81-72 in the championship game in Freedom Hall.

The average margin of victory in the series is just over six points a game. The biggest win was Louisville's 84-71 victory in Freedom Hall, February 1, 1979.

Outside the Metro, Louisville and Florida State have three common opponents, Minnesota, Missouri, and Marquette.

Minnesota beat both Florida State and Louisville by scores of 79-66 and 62-56 respectively. The Seminoles defeated Missouri 68-64 in the Cotton States Classic in Atlanta while Louisville will host the Tigers tomorrow. Both teams will face Marquette later in the season.

This may seem incredible but Louisville has gone 56 consecutive games without breaking the 100 point bar-

rier. The last time the Cardinals cracked the century mark was against Memphis State, 103-82 during the 1978-79 season.

The last time Louisville went so long without hitting 100 was a 64 game span from 1963-1966. Louisville buried Georgetown College 113-82 in the 1963-1964 season opener and did not score 100 points in a game again until 1966 when it defeated Bradley 103-71.

Florida State starts a huge front line consisting of 6-9, 210, senior Kris Anderson and 6-5, 200, junior James Bozeman at forwards and 6-10, 215, senior Elvis Rolle at center.

Anderson and Bozeman sat out last season. Anderson was academically ineligible and Bozeman had a torn achilles tendon.

Oren Gilmore, a 6-9, 190, freshman forward from Chicago provides depth on the front line. He is the brother of Florida State assistant Frank Gilmore and Artis Gilmore of the Chicago Bulls.

Bobby Parks and All-Metro performer Mickey Dillard start at guard.

Tonight's game will be the first time Louisville assistant Bob Dotson will coach against his old team. He was an assistant to Florida State head coach Joe Williams on the Seminole staff the past two years.

It will also be the first home game for Louisville freshman center Charles Jones. Jones missed the first three home games with a toe injury.

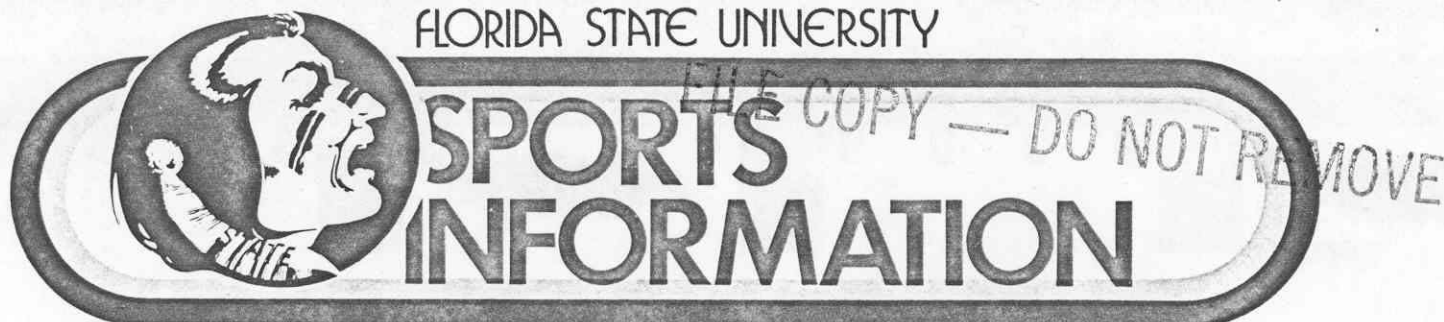

THE GAME--Tonight's contest matches the two teams that met in last season's Metro Conference Championship. The Cardinals captured that 81-72 on their way to the NCAA Championship. Louisville has captured six straight games from the Seminoles dating back to the 1977-78 season when the Tribe took an 81-70 verdict. FSU comes into the game after suffering their first loss after two straight wins. The Seminoles were defeated 80-70 in overtime by Virginia Tech Monday to lower their Metro record to 2-1. The Cardinals have taken advantage of Conference play winning two straight, a 73-53 win over Tulane and an 83-68 triumph over Cincinnati Saturday. Louisville is 2-0 in the Metro.

THE LAST MEETING --The last time the two squads met, Louisville captured the Metro title with a perfect 14-0 record. The loss marked the third consecutive year the Seminoles finished second in the Conference championship. Overall, Louisville holds an 11-3 lead.

THE COACHES--The Seminoles are guided by third year mentor Joe Williams (SMU '56) who has a 282-172 record in 16 plus years of coaching. Williams' previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1964-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 142-87). With the Seminoles, Williams is 48-24 in two plus seasons. The Cardinals are guided by tenth year Denny Crum. With Louisville Crum has amassed a 223-62 mark in his 10th season. Louisville is the only head coaching stop for Crum.

LOUISVILLE AND THE METRO--Including two Metro wins this season, Louisville has captured 16 straight Conference wins. The last Cardinal Metro loss was a defeat at the hands of Virginia Tech in the finals of the 1979 Conference Tournament.

BAD STARTS--Beginning the season, the Cardinals dropped their first three contests without a win. The Seminoles also had a rough start, winning only twice in their first five outings.

1000 POINTS--This season, Louisville forward Derek Smith tallied his 1,000th point in a Cardinal uniform. Smith is only the 25th player in Cardinal history to accomplish that feat.

NEXT--The Seminoles remain on the road and return south to face Jacksonville Tuesday while Louisville will have 24-hours rest before meeting Missouri again at Freedom Hall.
