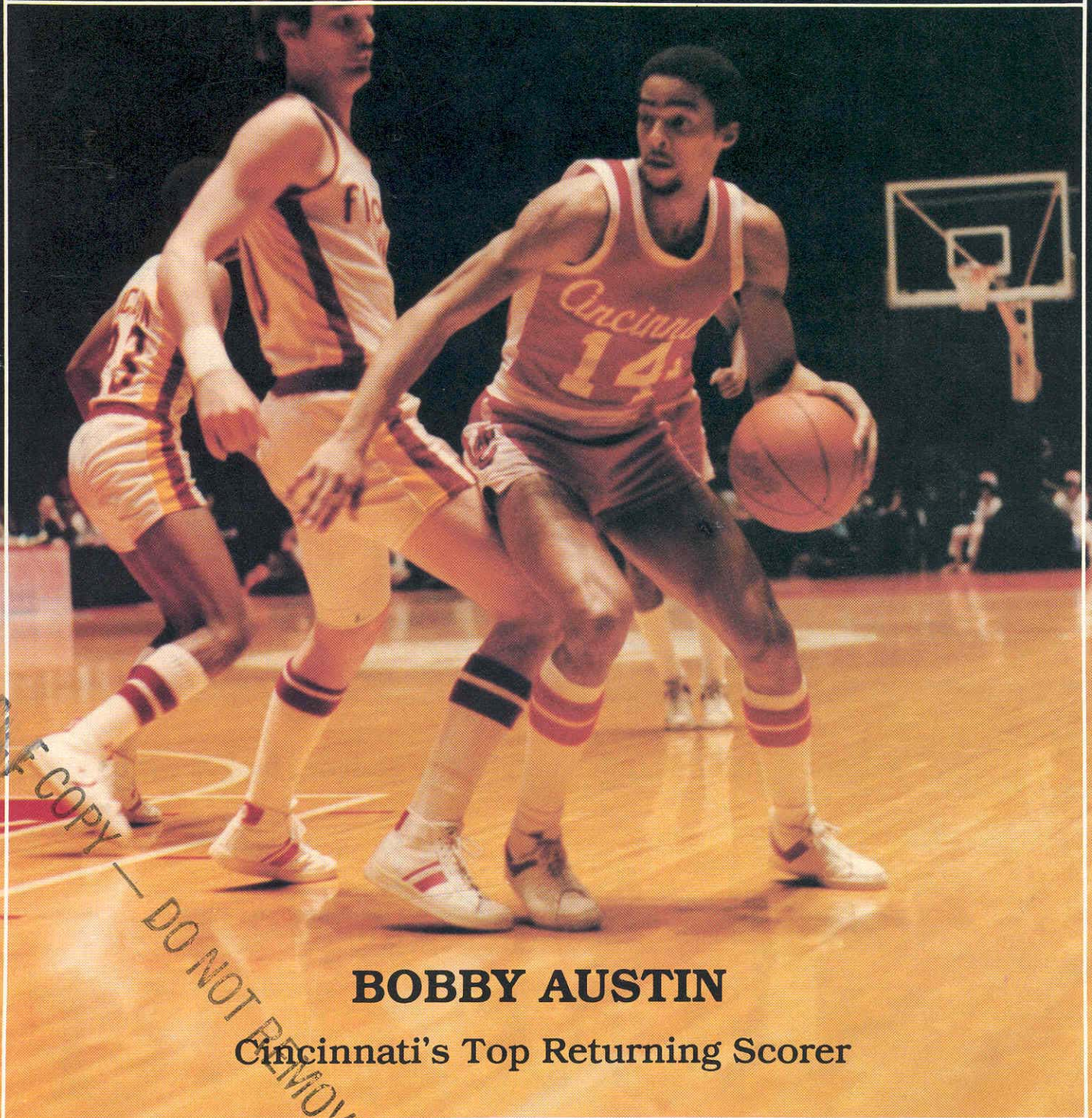

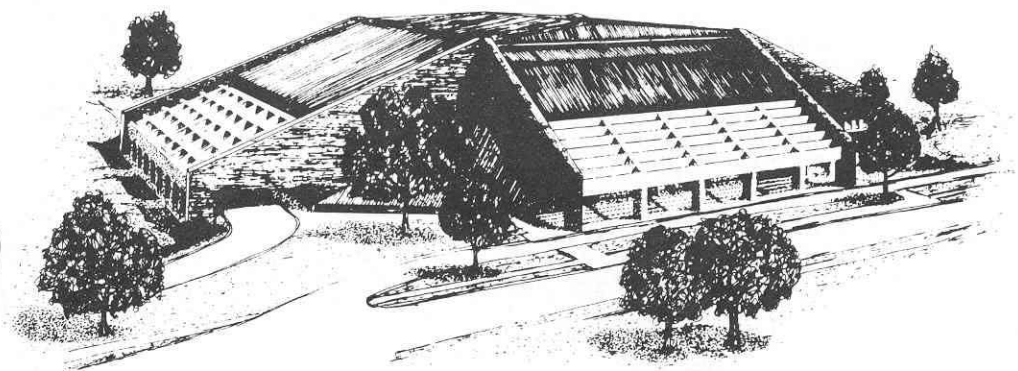

THE GAME--Today's game matches 12-8 (5-4 Metro) Florida State vs. 11-10 Cincinnati (4-4 Metro). The two Metro foes have met once already this season with the Seminoles capturing a 79-77 victory at Cincinnati. Prior to this afternoon's contest, the Seminoles defeated St. Louis Monday 70-57 at Tallahassee. The FSU win snapped a two game losing streak. The Bearcats come to Tully Gym with a three game win streak including victories over Metro foes Memphis State (65-62) and Tulane (91-76). Cincinnati has won four of its last six ballgames.

THE LAST MEETING--In the Seminoles 79-77 win earlier this season, guard Bobby Parks led all scorers tallying a career high 20 points. Tops for the Bearcats was David Kennedy with 17. With the victory the Tribe raised their series advantage to 8-3.

SMILE--Today's contest is the Metro Game of the Week and will be broadcast nation wide on the Metro Network. The TV appearance marks the second time in a week FSU has appeared on television. Last week the Tribe lost in overtime to Louisville before a national audience.

WHO'S THAT?--In the last three ballgames Cincinnati has utilized a 'new look' offense. Named the "High-Low Contact-Expand Quick Motion Game," the Bearcats have been working the ball inside with great success. In the last three games, Cincinnati has shot an amazing .575 and in the past two games have set back-to-back school field goal percentage records. Against Memphis State, the Bearcats shot .628, and Tuesday vs. Tulane they hit .633 from the field. The previous school record was .627 set all the way back in 1965.

BENEFITING--Probably helped most from the 'new look' Cincinnati offense is forward Doc Holden who has hit 19 of 33 shots in a three game stretch for a .575 average.

THE COACHES--The Seminoles are led by third year mentor Joe Williams who has a 287-174 record in 16 plus years of coaching. Williams previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1964-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 92-61). With the Seminoles, Williams is 53-26 in two plus seasons. The Bearcats are led by third year coach Ed Badger. With Cincinnati Badger is 37-39 in two plus seasons. Prior to accepting the Cincinnati assignment, Badger coached two seasons with the Chicago Bulls of the NBA amassing an 84-79 mark. Before the Bulls Badger tutored the Wright Junior College basketball team to a 352-110 record.

100 PLUS ONE--Today's contest marks forward Kris Anderson's 101 game as a Seminole. Monday vs. St. Louis Anderson participated in game 100 in his career.

JUST WONDERING--Besides Anderson moving up in the record book in games played (7th, tied with Greg Grady trailing Wayne Smalls by four), other Seminoles too are placing their names on the All-Time lists. Guard Mickey Dillard is the second all-time leading Seminole scorer with 1568 points trailing Jim Oler with 1820. Dillard's name also appears in field goals made (576, 5th trailing Reggie Royals' 580), field goals attempted (1129, 8th trailing Ron King's 1170) and games played (107, 2nd behind Harry Davis' and Tony Jackson's 108). Also in games played is guard Bobby Parks who has played in 89 contests (9th, behind Jim Oler's 91). Finally, Anderson is moving up in rebounds. The 6-9 senior now has 645 (8th, behind Harry Davis' 734) for his career.

THE OFFICIALS--Today's referee is Willie Brown and the umpires are Rich Eichorst and Ken Lauderdale.

NEXT--The Seminoles take a brief rest and prepare to host Virginia Tech Monday at 7:30. The Bearcats return home to meet Xavier Wednesday.
