

Florida State

At press time the Seminoles were 2-4 with games to be played on December 19th (vs Auburn) and December 22nd (vs S. Carolina).

After starting with an 81-67 win over Florida A&M the "Tribe" lost a close one to Georgia (70-67) before going to The Florida Four Tournament. After trailing at the half 51-37 the Seminoles came back to edge out Jacksonville 94-93 in overtime. In the championship game against South Florida the Seminoles trailed by two at the half, but the taller, more experienced Brahman squad finally wore the Tribe down and won 82-67. Florida State earned the runner up trophy. The Seminoles were not as lucky when they met Jacsonville for a second game at the Tallahassee-Leon County Civic Center. It was another close contest but this time Jacksonville came out on top 83-80. Florida State then bowed to Florida 81-65 in a game at the Jacksonville Coliseum.

Experience had been mentioned as a key to the Seminoles loss to South Florida in the Florida Four Tournament. Absent from the starting line up are senior guard James Bozeman (bruised knee) and forward Pernell Tookes (torn ligaments in left knee). Two transfer players Mitchell Wiggins and Bobby Miles became eligible with the Seminoles December 19th game against Auburn and are expected to be big contributors to the success of the 81-82 season. Wiggins is a forward from Clemson who began his career as a Junior College All-American at McDonnell Junior College. Miles is 6-8 center who sat out with a pre-season injury at Georgia last year.

With four experienced people out the Seminoles had a starting lineup of 3 sophomores and 2 freshmen. Statistically, four of the top five positions in scoring and rebounding are held by newcomers. Only returning Soph. Oren Gilmore (4th) is in the scoring top five and the now injured Bozeman is tied for third in rebounds.

The Seminoles are led by fourth year coach Joe Williams who is 294·181 in seventeen years of coaching. His record with the Tribe is 60·33. Previous coaching stints have been with Jacksonville (1965 - 1970; 92·61) and Furman (1970-1978; 142·87). Williams led the Dolphins to the NCAA finals vs (ICLA in 1970 and still ranks as the winningest coach in Furman History.

UNC Charlotte

The University of North Carolina-Charlotte is off to a perfect 6-0 start this year. This matches the schools best start since their 1975-1976 NIT Team. UNCC has also won 57 straight games in its 3,200 seat campus gymnasium.

All six games have been played at home starting with UNC Ashville (67-64), Penn State (88-78) and U. of Charleston (52-45). The 49ers won its fourth First Union Holiday Classic title in five years by defeating Holy Cross (59-57) and cross county rival Davidson College (78-71) in the finals. Then UNCC defeated Campbell 71-69. The 49ers will take a 13 day break before their first road trip of the season to play in tonight's game against Florida St.

UNCC has four starters returning this year. They are senior guard Phil Ward (18.8 p.p.g./2.8 r.p.g.), 6-9 sophomore forward Melvin Johnson (12.6 p.p.g./6.8 r.p.g.), senior forward Bobby Potts (18.6 p.p.g./6.0 r.p.g.), and 6-8 junior center Lawrence Furlow (7.8 p.p.g./5.8 r.p.g.). Senior guard Matt Houpt (6.6 p.p.g./2.6 r.p.g.) will round out this years probable starting line-up.

Last year 10-17 season was the 49ers first losing season in 11 years on the division I level. Because of an injury to Potts which caused him to be red shirted and the academic ineligibility of their leading rebounder, the 49ers juggled eight different starting lineups last season. Those problems are obviously behind them now.

Head coach Mike Pratt is no stranger to the Dayton area. Born and raised in Dayton he played high school ball at Meadowdale and became one of the city leagues all time leading scorers. Playing under the legendary Adolph Rupp (1967-1970), Pratt led the Wildcats to three consecutive NCAA tournaments and a combined 76-10 record at starting forward. He was three times named to the all-Southeastern conference team and was a Converse and Academic All-American in 1970.
