THE GAME--Tonight's contest will be the rubber game of the season for the two schools. December 4, at the Florida Four Tournament in Tampa, FSU defeated JU 94-93 and five days later in Tallahassee, Jacksonville avenged that loss topping FSU 83-80 at the Leon County Civic Center. In the first game, Seminole guard Tony William hit a banking layup with three seconds remaining to give Florida State an overtime win. William led FSU scorers with 22 points and Terry Brush topped the Dolphins with 26. In the second game, FSU led 41-38 at the half, but behind Mike Hackett's 27 points on the evening JU stormed back for the win. David Speights led Florida State scorers with 17. Overall, FSU holds a 23-15 series advantage dating back to the 1959-60 season.

LATELY--Tonight's game matches two very hot teams. Florida State has won its last five straight outings -- its longest win streak in two seasons -- to go over the .500 mark in regular season and conference games. FSU began the win streak against Florida January 11, beating the Gators 82-67 in Tallahassee. The Tribe's last game was Monday when the team routed St. Leo 101-74. Guard Mitchell Wiggins led all scorers with 27 points. All 12 men on the Florida State roster scored.

Jacksonville has also been on a tear winning four of its last six games. JU's last outing was Friday when the team defeated South Alabama at Mobile 95-91 in overtime. Mike Hackett led the Dolphins with 27 points and Barlow Taylor hit a career high 17.

HOMECOMING--The game will be a homecoming for FSU head coach Joe Williams and assistant Rex Morgan. Williams coached the Dolphins from 1965-70 earning a 92-61 ledger. He took the squad to the NCAA finals against UCLA in 1970 and finished the season 27-2. Morgan played under Williams from 1968-70 averaging 23 points per game. He was an All-America selection in 1969 and is a member of the Florida All-Decade team.

GOING STRONG--After 11 games, rising star Mitchell Wiggins has not faded at all.

Gaining eligibility after the sixth game of the season, he tops the team in scoring with a 26.7 points per game average and a 10.1 rebounds per game mark. He has been held under 20 only once, and has scored 37 twice -- ninth highest FSU single game. He has been selected the Metro Conference Player of the Week twice -- the only conference player to earn that distinction --

and was Honeywell Player of the Game in a regionally televised contest on CBS.

- CENTURY 21--No, it is not a real estate company, it was No. 21 Scott Wilkes who hit the front of a two shot foul against St. Leo to put FSU over the 100 point mark. It was the first time FSU has broken the 100 plateau since 1979-80 when the team did it three times.
- MORE ON MITCH--Wiggins' importance is further emphasised when you consider the Tribe was 2-4 prior to him gaining eligibility. With the 6'4" junior FSU is 7-4.

Jacksonville is in a similar position with guard Maurice Roulhac. Forced to miss the first six games, JU was 2-4. Since his return, the squad has been 6-6.

- NOT A ONE MAN SHOW--While Wiggins has been the star of the show, he has had a very strong supporting cast. Every starter for the Tribe is in double figures, and guard Tony William leads the team in steals and assists. David Speights is second on the team in rebounds with a 6.0 average, and Mike Johnson is second on the team in assists with 61.
- THE COACHES—The Tribe is led by Joe Williams (SMU '56) who earned win No. 300 against St. Louis Saturday. In 17 plus seasons his ledger reads 301-186. Williams has coached at Jacksonville (1965-70; 92-61), Furman (1970-78; 142-87) and now Florida State (1978-; 67-38).

The Dolphins are guided by Bob Wenzel in his first head coaching assignment. Wenzel last coached as an assistant under Bill Foster at South Carolina
