THE GAME--Tonight No. 5 Metro Conference team Florida State (4-5) faces No. 6 Conference foe Cincinnati (1-8) in the first meeting of the season between the two squads. The Bearcats are the only Metro school FSU has not faced this season.

THE LAST MEETING--The last time the two squads met was in the 1981 Metro Conference championship with Cincinnati taking a 58-57 verdict. During the regular season, the Tribe topped UC 79-77 at Cincinnati and the Bearcats defeated FSU 80-79 at Tallahassee. Overall, the Tribe holds a 8-5 series advantage dating back to the 1971-72 season.

LATELY--Its been nothing but hard luck for the Tribe since defeating Louisville 71-65 at Tallahassee, January 30. FSU has lost its last three games, two in a row by a total of three points. Following the Cardinal contest, FSU has suffered losses to Tulane 66-53, Tulane again 62-61 and most recently Memphis State Saturday 62-60. Better news is reported from the Bearcat camp. After losing seven straight regular season games and eight consecutive Metro games dating back to January 18, UC defeated Virginia Tech 87-81 Monday for its first conference win. High scorer for UC was Bobby Austin who scored 24 points.

BACK ON TRACK--After being held under 20 points for three consecutive games, FSU guard Mitchell Wiggins broke out of his slump and added 26 points and 12 rebounds vs. Memphis State. The two time Metro Player of the Week leads the conference in scoring with a 23.8 average. He is also grabbing 9.4 rebounds per game. If Wiggins continues on his current pace, he will be the first Seminole to win the conference scoring crown.

GETTING TO KNOW YOU--For those who aren't familiar with the 1981-82 Seminoles, here are some facts. Only one player returns from last year's squad and that is sophomore center Oren Gilmore. In FSU's starting lineup, there is one freshman, three sophomores and a junior. The remainder of the Florida State roster consists of three freshmen and four sophomores. There are no seniors on the team.

OUR REGGIE--The 'straw that stirs the Seminole drink' this season is guard Tony William. William is second in scoring behind Wiggins (13.3) and tops the team in assists (96) and steals (52). William is the floor general running the FSU attack at both ends of the floor. He is the top free throw shooter on the squad (.833) and has scored in double figures all but six games.

YOU AGAIN--Tonight's contest will make the 51st consecutive game for center Oren Gilmore. Gilmore played in all 28 games last season as a freshman in a reserve role and this year he has started all 23 contests. He is third on the team in scoring (11.1) and first in blocked shots (14).

THE COACHES--The Tribe is led by fourth year coach Joe Williams (SMU '56) who is 68-42 in three plus seasons at the Tribe helm. Williams' previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1965-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 142-87). Overall, Williams' coaching ledger is 302-189 in 17 plus seasons. The Bearcats are tutored by Ed Badger who is 54-11 since taking over the Bearcats.
