THE GAME--Tonight's contest is the second meeting this season between the two schools. Florida State defeated South Carolina 82-77 December 22, at Columbia.

THE LAST MEETING—In that game, the Tribe broke a four game losing streak, while the Gamecocks had a two game win streak snapped. In only his second game since gaining eligibility, FSU guard Mitchell Wiggins scored a season high 37 points to lead the Florida State attack. Fellow guard Tony William chipped in 16. High for the Gamecocks was Jimmy Hawthorne who had 24 points. Overall, the series is tied 3-3 dating back to the 1960-61 season.

LATELY--There may not be two more frustrated teams in the nation. In the Seminoles' last three games, the squad has lost by four points. The streak of bad luck began with 62-61 loss to Tulane, followed by a 62-60 defeat by Memphis State, and most recently an 84-83 upset by Cincinnati Saturday at Riverfront Coliseum. In that game, 59 fouls were called--35 on Florida State. Four players fouled out including three Seminoles. The Gamecocks have been equally snake bit suffering three defeats by a total of seven points. The three game losing streak includes Davidson 52-51, Penn State 62-60 and Notre Dame Saturday 59-55.

SCORING LEADERS MOVE OVER--They'd better be ready at Shawnee Mission, Kansas, because after tonight's game, FSU super guard Mitchell Wiggins will be eligible for NCAA ranking. NCAA rules state that a player must play in 75% of a team's games. Wiggins gained eligibility after game six, and now in game 24 he has played 18 of 24 contest, or 75%. According to the latest NCAA stats released February 15, Wiggins 24.1 average would place him fifth.

AND IN ST LOUIS--Not only will Wiggins 24.1 average put him among the nation's leaders, but his scoring ability makes him the favorite to win the Metro Conference scoring title. Wiggins would be the first Florida State player to earn that

honor. Keith Lee of Memphis State is second at 18.5.

MORE ON MITCH--In Wiggins last two games, he has scored 55 points and pulled down 32 rebounds. Against Cincinnati he led both teams in scoring with 29 points, and both teams in rebounds with 20. In 17 games, he has not been held under double figures and has scored 20 or more points 13 times. The 6-4 guard has been named Metro Player of the Week twice, and the Honeywell Player of the Game in a nationally televised broadcast.

TRIBE TALK—Freshman Raphael Phillip is expected to start his second game in the garnet and gold. Phillip earned his first start Saturday against Cincinnati scoring four points and grabbing two rebounds. Center Oren Gilmore continues to be the Lou Gehrig of FSU basketball. This game will mark the 52nd consecutive game Gilmore has played in since his freshman year. He played all 28 games his first season in a reserve role, and this year he has begun every game as a starter. Guard Tony William is only two assists away from 100 for the season. The 6-1 guard already is in 12th place on the FSU single season assist list. He needs 13 more assists to take over 11th place from Wayne Smalls (1974-75).

CAROLINA CHATTER—Gamecock guard Gerald Peacock is no stranger to the assist column. The junior has already dealt out 116 assists this season. Forward Brad Jergenson hopes to repeat the performance he had against the Irish Saturday. Jergenson scored a career high 19 points in the four point loss. Carolina may argue that tonight's outcome may be different with Jimmy Foster. The starting center was absent when FSU defeated the Gamecocks. Foster missed the first

nine USC games.

THE COACHES—The Tribe is led by fourth year coach Joe Williams (SMU '56) who is 68-43 in three plus seasons at the Tribe helm. Williams' previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1965-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 142-87). Overall, Williams' coaching ledger is 302-189 in 17 plus seasons. The Gamecocks are tutored by Bill Foster who is one win shy of career win 350. In 22 plus seasons he is 349-214. In two seasons at the South Carolina helm, he is 28-25. Foster's previous assignments have been at Duke, Utah, Rutgers and Bloomsburg State.
