THE GAME--Today's regionally televised game on NBC-TV will be a battle for fifth place in the Metro Conference. The game is the second meeting between the two schools this season. Cincinnati took an 84-83 decision February 20, at Riverfront Coliseum.

THE LAST MEETING--To say it was a typical FSU - UC game would be true and false.

Typically, it was decided by one point -- the last three meetings have been one point decisions -- but rarely have two teams been called for 59 fouls -- 35 on Florida State. Between the two teams, there were 101 rebounds (UC 52; FSU 49), four players fouled out (FSU 3; UC 1) and the Bearcats were victorious while shooting only 37.8 percent from the floor. With three seconds remaining, Bearcat Dwight Jones went to the line in a one and one situation with UC leading 84-83. Jones missed the front end, but grabbed his own rebound and held on for the win. Jones was high scorer for the Bearcats with 22 points, followed by Bobby Austin with 19. Seminole guard Mitchell Wiggins earned game high honors with 29 points. Wiggins also led both teams in rebounding with 20. Overall, FSU owns an 8-6 series edge.

LATELY--To say FSU has been unlucky the last five games would be putting it mildly.

The Tribe owns a six game losing streak, but in the last five losses FSU has been defeated by a total of eight points. Thursday against Virginia Tech, FSU trailed 77-76 with a chance to win the game with 10 seconds remaining. FSU guard Tony William brought the ball down court, and attempted to pass the ball inside to center Oren Gilmore. The ball bounced free, and a jump ball was called. Under new NCAA rules, it was Cincinnati's turn of possession, and the game ended in another FSU loss. The Bearcats too have been streaking, but in a positive direction. UC has captured its last three straight games -- all against Metro opponents. In the squad's last game Thursday at St. Louis, UC defeated the Billikins 76-61. Bobby Austin and Dwight Jones shared honors for the winners with 19 points each. Mike Williams led all rebounders with 18.

LOOKING BACK--As it is when you look to the past, the news wasn't always good. The last time the Tribe had a six game losing streak was 1957-58 when the team finished 9-16. The last seven game losing streak was 1952-53 when the team finished an even .500, 11-11. The longest Florida State losing streak ever was 13 games -- the last game in 1950-51, and the first 12 games of 1951-52.

SCORING MACHINE—Really all season, but especially the last four games, FSU guard Mitchell Wiggins has been unstoppable. The fifth leading scorer in the nation, Wiggins has scored lll points and grabbed 51 rebounds in his last four outings. Overall, Wiggins has not been held under double figures since gaining eligibility in the seventh game of the year. With his 24.3 average he has all but clinched the conference scoring title making him the first FSU player to earn that honor. He has scored 37 points on two occasions, and has a season high 20 rebounds. Wiggins has been Metro Player of the Week twice, and the Honeywell Player of the Game in a regionally televised contest.

SMOKE SIGNALS--FSU guard Tony William broke the century mark in assists now registering 103 for the season. That places him in 12th place on the FSU single season list, eight back from Wayne Smalls (1974-75). Center Oren Gilmore will have played in every game for FSU since joining the team as a freshman. The 6-9 sophomore played in all 28 games last year in a reserve role, and will have played in all 26 regular season games this year as a starter for a total 54 consecutive appearances.

CLAW MARKS -- To say Cincinnati is a streaking team would be an understatement. Prior to jumping on the winning bandwagon, UC had lost seven straight. Individually, Cincinnati players are streaking too. In his last four games, guard Bobby Austin has tallied 76 points for a 19.0 average. He is the eighth all time leading scorer in Bearcats history with 1349 points. Dwight Jones has also been hot of late hitting 18-26 field goal attempts (69.0 percent) in his last two games. In those contests, Jones has scored 22 and 19 points.

THE COACHES -- The Tribe is led by fourth year coach Joe Williams (SMU '56) who is 68-45 in three plus seasons at the Tribe helm. Williams' previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1965-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 142-87). Overall, Williams' coaching ledger is 302-191 in 17 plus seasons. The Bearcats are tutored by fourth year coach Ed Badger who is 56-53 at the UC reigns. Prior to his only collegiate coaching assignment, Badger was the head coach of the Chicago Bulls earning an 84-78 mark.


