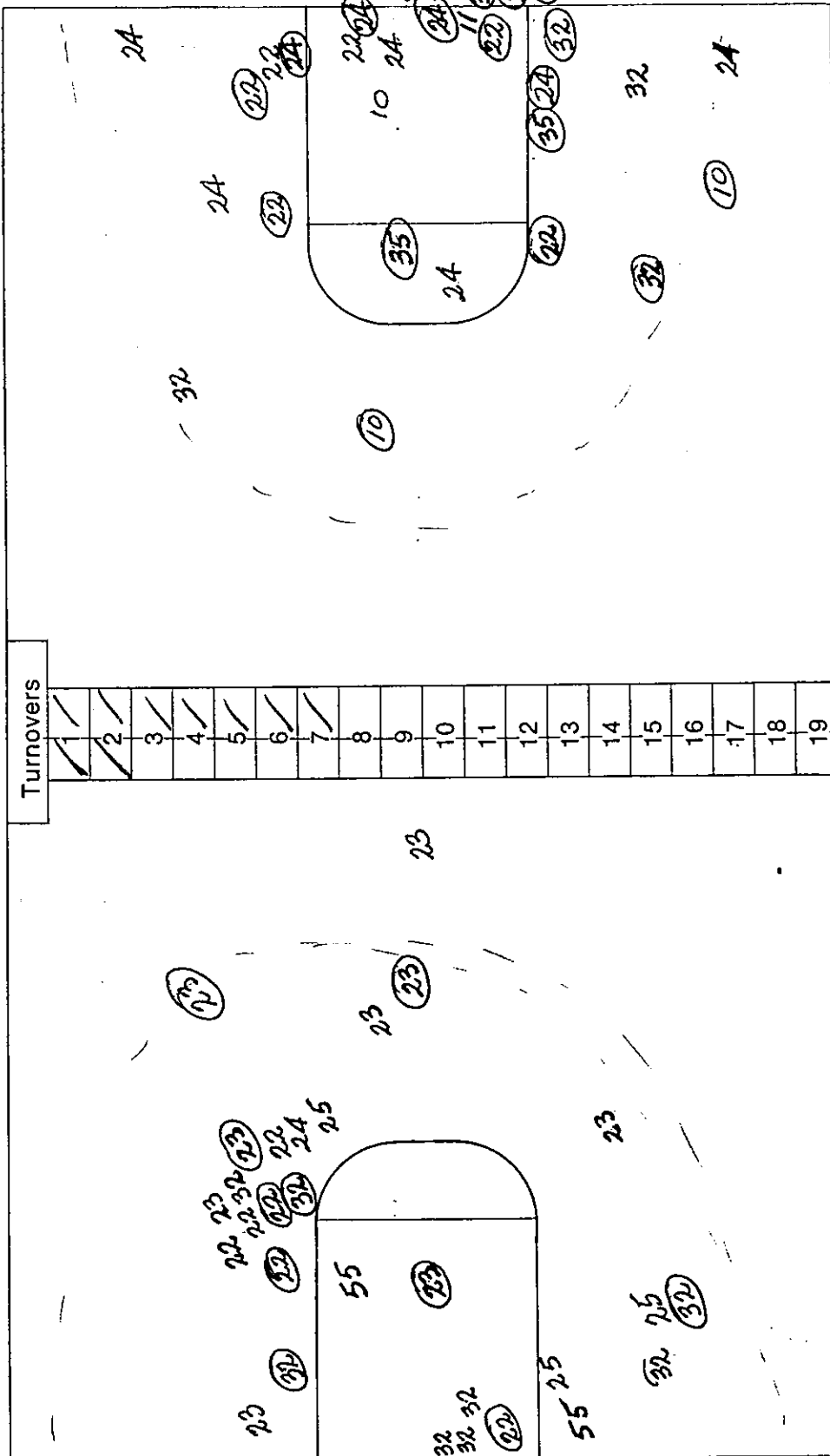

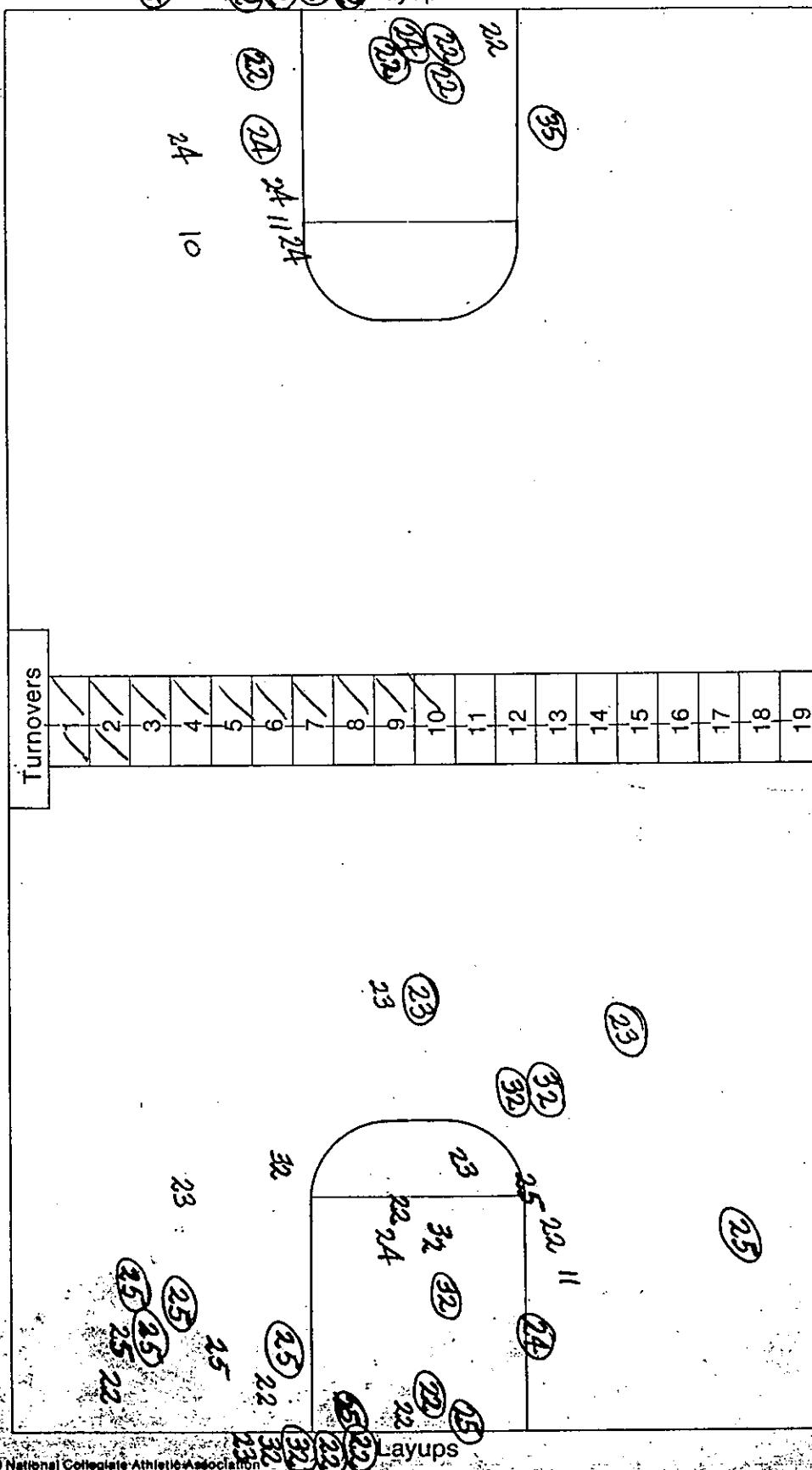

GAME # 1 Cincinnati vs Memphis State

1983 Metro Conference Tournament

March 11, 1983

Game Hi-Lites

First tipoff of the 1983 Metro Tournament is at 5:06 p.m.

First turnover of the tourney is by MSU at 19:53 on game clock.

First foul of tourney is at 19:22 by Maurice Myrick of FSU. He fouled Derrick Phillips of MSU. Phillips hit 1 of 2 FTs.

First field goal of tourney by Mitchell Wiggins of FSU at 19:15 - 14 ft. right of FT lane.

First MSU FG is at 18:03 by Bobby Parks - 8 foot baseline shot.

First stuff of tourney by Keith Lee at 13:32 of first half - dunk off of rebound of miss by Andre Turner.

First timeout of tourney called by Florida State at 12:58 of first half. MSU leading 15-12.

First delay of the game at 12:58 at end of first timeout as nation's top pom-pon squad was out on the floor too long. They were excused and forgiven.

At 9:07 of first half - MSU hitting 68.8% from field (11 of 16) and have 10 rebounds.

FSU is hitting 47.4% (9 of 19) and has 6 rebounds.

First substitution of game is made at 6:10 of first half - FSU's Phillips for Myrick.

First MSU substitution is McCoy for Turner at 5:19 of first half.

Hi-Lite editor observation of first half - what is MSU's Phil Cannon doing wearing sunglasses while keeping the Memphis official book?

FSU calls second timeout at 3:49 of first half.

Shooting bonus free throws for first time in tourney at 1:27 of first half.

FSU's Mike Johnson missed the front end of bonus.

MSU goes into "FIST" offense at about :45 seconds of first half. First boo of tourney accompanies the change in offense even though it results in easy basket by Keith Lee.

MSU has biggest lead of half on two free throws by Holmes at :03 (lead by 12) and stretches halftime score to 42-30 favor of Memphis State.

First standing ovation of night is for the MSU pom-pon squad halftime show. DYNAMITE!

19:23 of second half MSU scores first basket of second half. Parks off beautiful bounce pass from Lee. Stretches lead to 14 (46-32).

13:33 of second half: Both teams have only missed six shots. MSU is 5 of 7 for 71.4% while FSU is 6 of 10 for 60%. Score is 53-42 MSU.

Florida State calls its fourth timeout of game at 13:05, trailing 60-46.

After going out to its biggest lead, 60-46, Memphis State now only has a 63-58 lead with 9:05 remaining. In a span of 4 minutes and 1 second, the Seminoles have outscored the Tigers 12-3. Memphis State calls time out with 8:57 left in the game.

A first: ball gets stuck between rim and backboard at 6:24. Michael Johnson took the shot for the Seminoles and they could have cut the lead to one point (67-65--if he had made it).

Memphis State called time out at 4:50 remaining and when it came back went to the first offense (delay game).

GAME ONE FIRST ADD-----

At 3:06 remaining, Joe Williams, FSU's head coach, used a white towel as if to surrender while disputing an officials' call that went against the Seminoles.

Clutch free throw shooting by the Tigers down the stretch has enabled them to open up a five-point lead, 79-74. Key free throw shooters for the Tigers have been Bobby Parks and Phillip Haynes.

With 28 seconds remaining, Mitchell Wiggins ends his career as a Seminole by fouling out.

The attendance for the game is 6,136.

With just 15 seconds remaining, the Tigers crowd, noting their 80-74 lead, begins the chant: "We want Louisville; We want Louisville." If the Tigers hold on, they will play Louisville at 1:30 p.m. Saturday in the first semifinal game of the 1983 Metro Conference Tournament.

The final score: Memphis State 84, Florida State 74.

Memphis State, now 22-6 overall, moved on to play Louisville, while Florida State finishes the season with a 14-14 mark.

Dana Kirk is now 69-48 at Memphis State for his four-year career. Joe Williams is now 83-61 in five years at Florida State.

Memphis State forward Bobby Parks scored 33 points against FSU. 33 points is Parks' career high point total and marks the first time Parks has scored 30 or more points in his three years at MSU. His previous high game was a 27 point effort against S.W. Louisiana in 1981-82.

JOE WILLIAMS - FLORIDA STATE

Memphis St. played a great ball game, except for the one spurt where we forced them out of their game. The only chance we had was to do just that--to force them out of their game. I thought we did it real well. Who knows, ~~xx~~ when we took Tony William~~x~~ out (when he sprained his ankle) it may have been a mistake. We didn't have our good outside shooting with him out. We knew if we ~~x~~ could get things right, we may have had a chance, .b I thought we played well under the circumstances. They didn't help ~~xx~~ us out at all. They hit all their free throws.
