## QUICKIE QUOTES

MEMPHIS STATE COACH DANA KIRK --

"It didn't look like Heddy Lamarr (sic) -- it wasn't very pretty, but it was awfully good to win that one.

We got in the hole early and it takes time to dig your way out. I told them (the players) at halftime that we had 20 more minutes. The ball game was a triller. We were in serious foul trouble. I hoped we can play tomorrow without this kind of foul trouble.

We kept going inside. I knew they expected that, so we kept going.

At the end, I think Doom (Haynes) was the only senior on the floor and we wanted the senior to take the shoot. He made a good move."

PHILLIP "DOOM" HAYNES --

Coach Kirk drew up the play and it worked just like he put it on the board.

Andre threw it out to me on the wing and I went one-on-one.

(Tony) Williams picked me up early, but I got around him and tried for a layup, but some Florida State player stuck his hand up and I kept my mind strictly on hitting the shot.

MEMPHIS STATE VS. FLORIDA STATE

Losing Coach - Joe Williams "We played well and hard and scrapped in the first half. We played good defense, it just came down to missing the front end of three one-and-one in crucial game situations. It is difficult to guess what kind of play an opponent has in mind in that situation. I didn't think we had it defended badly.-- in a pressure situation like that it will either fall or not. Our kids (Shaffer and William) played hard and were tired. They didn't miss those free throws on purpose. they are good shooters and have nothing to be ashamed of.

Losing Player - Tony William

"The momentum changed on us. In the first half we got ahead by being patient on offense. We were able to get the ball into Al Gipson and Granville Arnold hit some big shots for us. The Second team did well also. Memphis State came back hard and they deserve credit. I'm not real upset because I feel our season isn't over yet. We could get an NIT bid or still possible an NCAA bid."

## 1984 METRO CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

### Semifinal Round

#### Memphis State 65, Florida State 63

Phillip Haynes eight-foot bank shot with three seconds remaining in the game lifted Memphis State from the ruins of a 13-point early second half deficit to a 65-63 nail biter over Florida State in the semifinals of the Metro Conference Tournament.

The MSU win, its 23rd of the season, propelled the Tigers into Saturday's tourney championship contest against Virginia Tech, a 69-61 winner over top-seeded Louisville in the first semifinal game of the evening.

After trailing 43-30 with 18:19 left in the game, Memphis State began chipping away at Florida State's lead, and in the end, FSU's inability to hit the free throws that it had hit so well in the first half (11 of 13) proved to be its downfall.

The host Tigers took their first lead in more than 20 minutes when Willie Becton canned a 14-foot bank with 2:37 remaining in the game. Their last lead had come late in the first half, when they yielded to a cold spell that produced only one field goal in the final 7:11 of play in the first stanza.

Over that final seven-plus minutes of play in the first half, Florida State outscored Memphis State to take a 37-28 lead into intermission.

When All-America forward Keith Lee fouled out of the game with 2:52 remaining (only the second time he has fouled out in past two seasons), Memphis State slowed the pace of the game.

Following Becton's shot which gave MSU its 62-61 lead at 2:37, the Tigers never trailed again, although Florida State knotted the score at 63 and had a chance to take the lead. Point guard Tony William missed the front end of a one-and-one opportunity, and MSU got the rebound.

The Tigers worked the clock down to :18 and called time out, to set up what proved to be the winning basket as Haynes drove the right side of the lane and hit his eight-footer off the glass.

Memphis State will carry a 23-6 mark into Saturday's 1 p.m., nationally televised (CBS-TV) game with 18-11 Virginia Tech. Florida State saw its mark fall to 19-10.
