

COACH JOE WILLIAMS:

"This is a great way to go out. I've got a lot of great memories at Florida State. Wendy and I both have had a lot of good things happen to us. I wish the new coach the best in the future.

COACH BILL FOSTER:

"I thought we had a great opportunity here today and let it slip away. We didn't attack their press or the basket late in the game. We just didn't have a take charge person today. We mishandled the basketball and had too many turnovers in the second half.

"Randy Allen was tremendous in the second half with the way he scored and rebounded. Jerome Fitchett played well for them and Tat Hunter gave them a lift off of the bench.

"I'm very disappointed. The last play of the first half gave them some ~~much~~ confidence. We were playing pretty well up until the 9 or 10 minute mark of the game. Then things just started going wrong.

"It hurt us early that Michael Foster was in foul trouble. He just wasn't as active today as he has been in the past."
