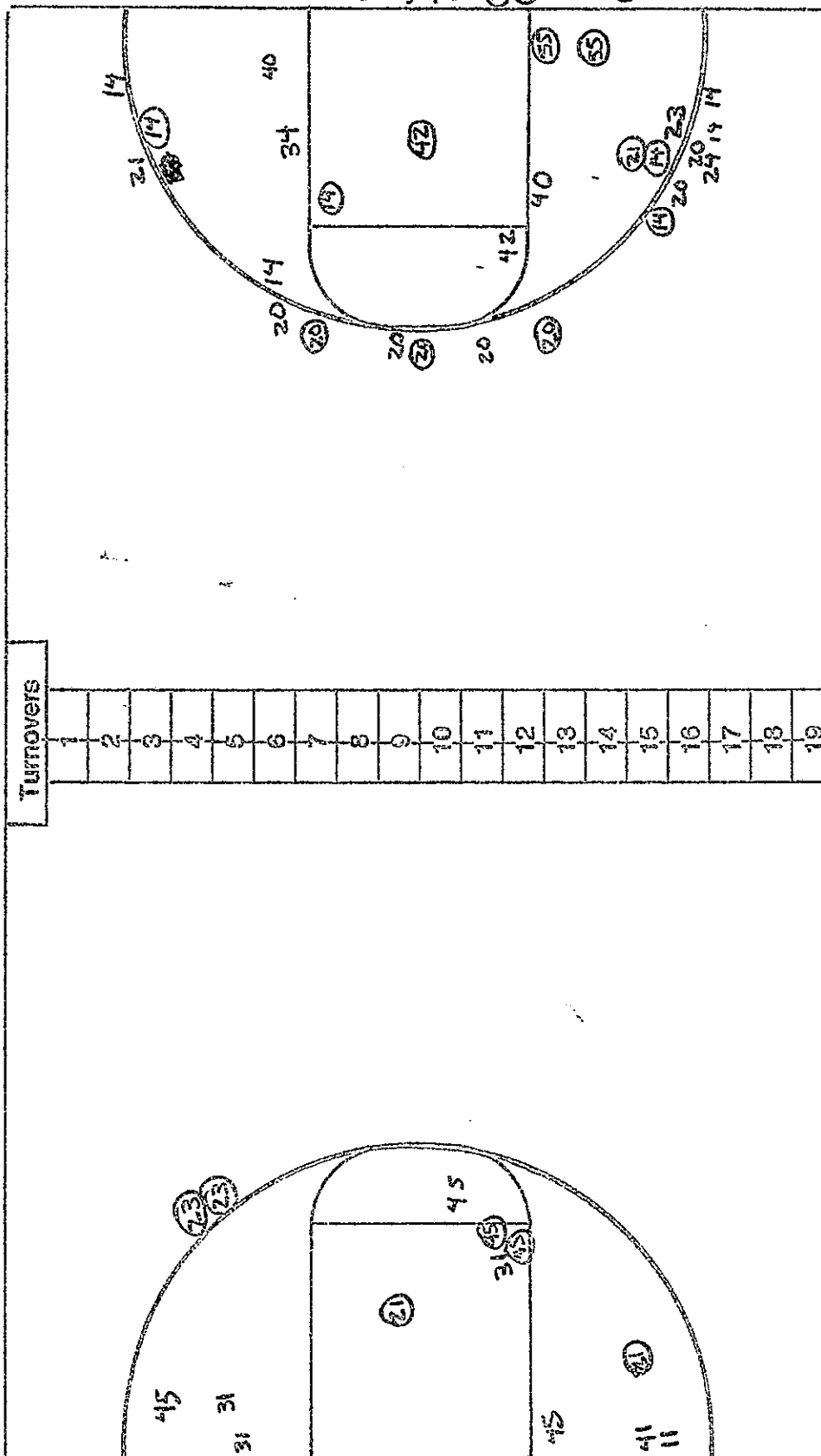

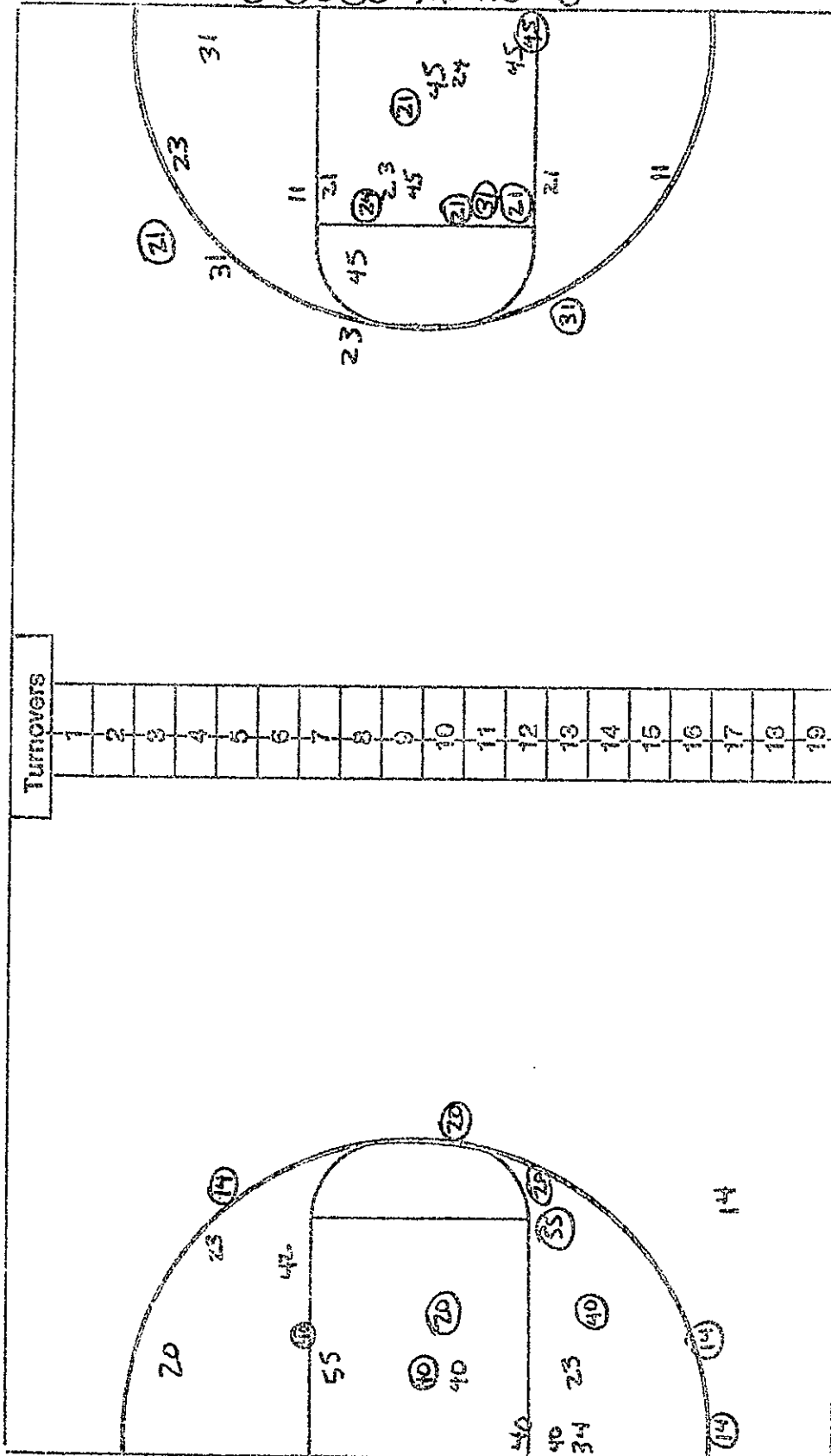

FLORIDA STATE'S PAT KENNEDY

"The kids executed the game plan. They went out and did it. We executed our defensive game plan exactly the way we designed it. Everyone had big plays tonight. We've just got to develop a complete balance inside and outside.

At the end of the game we wanted to shoot the ball after we would the clock down to 10 seconds. We wanted to get the ball to Pee Wee. On the last play we wanted Pee Wee to penetrate and get the ball to one of the two guys we had on the wings. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ He got the ball to Raleigh which was what we wanted. It sounds great doesn't it?

They've got a much stronger inside game with McKey and #45 (Ansley). We played in front of and behind McKey."

WE can play against anyone. There's no question in my mind. I'm just worried about getting our players and program into the NCAA. I want to leave here and go home and turn on ESPN and watch Sportscenter and hear them say "Florida State upsets 7th ranked Alabama tonight. There's a team we should start watching."

ALABAMA'S WINN SANDERSON

"This was a heartbreaking loss. But this game was not lost in the last seven seconds. It was lost in the first half when we were outrebounded 18-8. They pretty much controlled the latter part of the first half and the early part of the second half to gain control.

The responsibility of the loss goes to me. It's a disappointment to me because we had a great chance to win. We just didn't do the things we needed to do to win. As in all ~~XX~~ close games, there is a very small margin between victory and defeat. And we just didn't do it tonight.

Give Florida State credit. They played well enough to win and they were helped by a very supportive crowd.

Our game against Arkansas this Wednesday will be the best basketball game ~~XX~~ an Alabama team has played in Birmingham in many, many years. Arkansas is an outstanding basketball team and they should ~~XX~~ give our home crowd a good game."

Now we'll just have to go out and do a better job than we did tonight."
