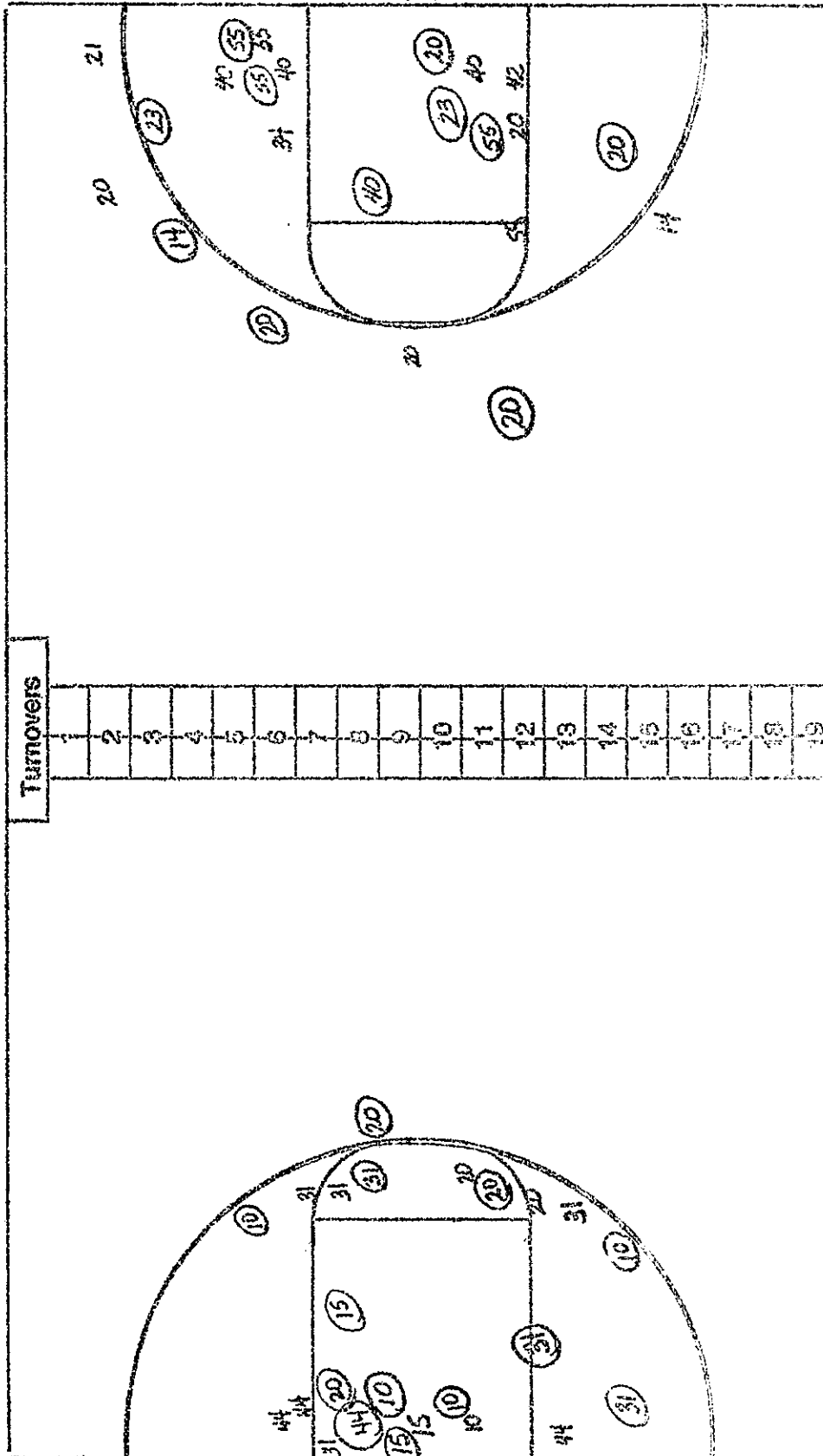
NCAA BASKETBALL SHOT CHART

Abstract OBJECTIVE: To determine the prevalence of self-reported mental health problems in a community sample of young adults. DESIGN: Cross-sectional survey. SETTING: A community sample of young adults. PARTICIPANTS: 1,000 young adults (18-24 years) were surveyed. MAIN RESULTS: The prevalence of self-reported mental health problems was 12.5%. The most common problems were anxiety disorders (5.5%), followed by depression (4.5%), and substance use disorders (3.5%). CONCLUSIONS: The prevalence of self-reported mental health problems in a community sample of young adults is 12.5%. The most common problems are anxiety disorders, followed by depression, and substance use disorders.

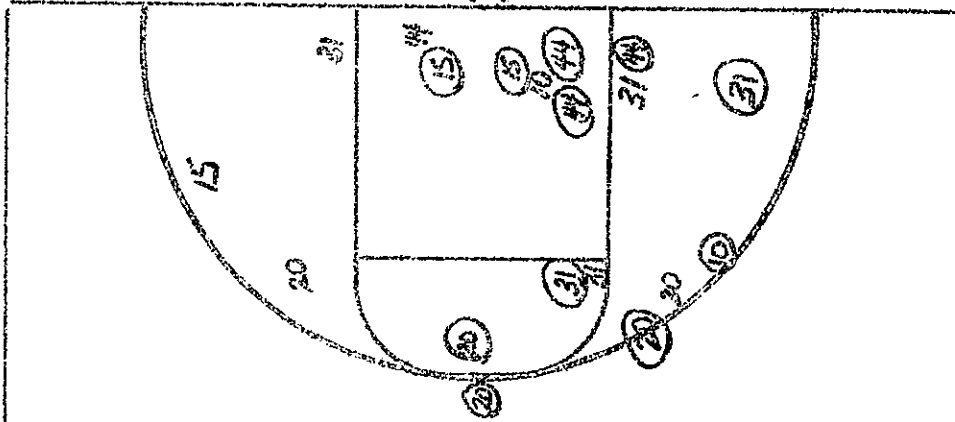

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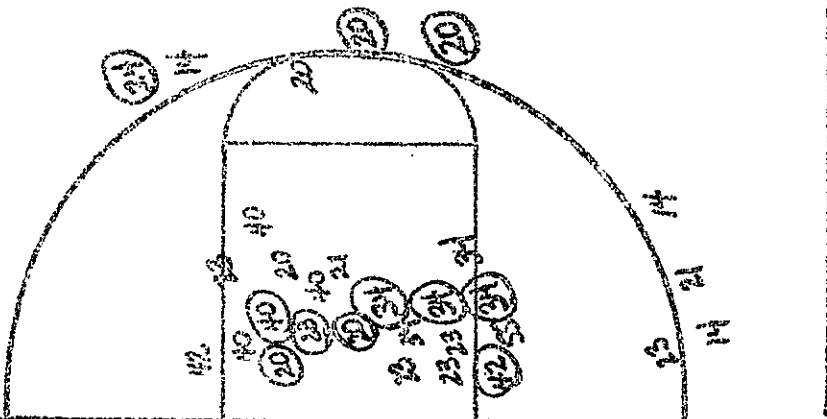

COACHES QUOTES

Florida State's Pat Kennedy

"A lot of credit goes to South Carolina. Their starting five were more consistent. We keep reaching every game to get some consistency but we just haven't found it yet. We're not getting real consistent play and that's hurting us. We've got to continue to work on individual play. We've got to get more out of some of the positions. Rudy Allen played 35 minutes and had five points and three rebounds; he took only eight shots. LaRae was one for five. We've got to get more out of those positions. They made some real good shots in the first half and that put us behind the 8-ball."

South Carolina's George Feston

"I'd like to compliment my team and staff on a tremendous conference win. At the beginning of the season our biggest goal was to put two halves together and in our last five games we've done just that. Defense has been our bread and butter. I thought we did a good job of protecting the ball. We had patience and controlled the tempo. In fact we did an excellent job of controlling the tempo and those are keys to winning on the road. Our defense has improved from day one it is just tough, man-for-man defense."

"I think Fla. State is a very good team. They've had some impressive wins against some very good teams."
