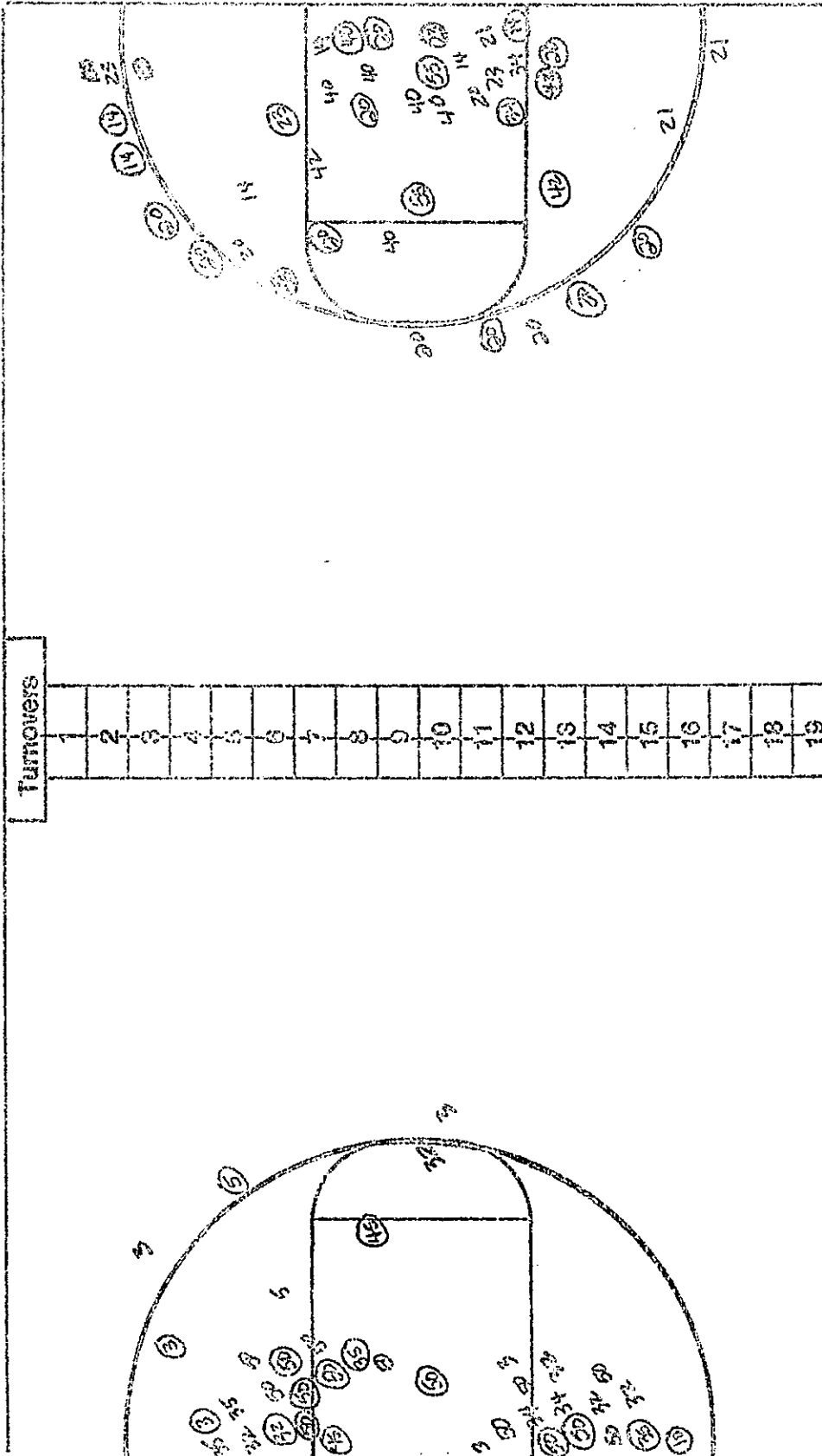

FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH PAT KENNEDY

"I thought it would be a hard fought effort and it was. They have done an outstanding job with Tito Horford. I thought he played very well. He's a dominating center and he'll be a great college player.

We thought we would give Pee Wee the green light ~~THAT~~ tonight. We looked at how Florida's guards played Miami and we thought Presto couldn't keep up with him. Pee Wee is exhausted right now and we've got to play in 48 hours for the biggest conference game of the season.

When they closed it to six we called a timeout and the kids did just what we asked them to do.

(About the NCAA tournament---) I think we're very much in the hunt.

MIAMI HEAD COACH BILL FOSTER

I must compliment FSU. They really ran the floor tonight. They took some good three point shots, but that's not what beat us. It was the way they ran the floor.

They scored as many points in the first half tonight than they did in the whole game in Miami. Our goal ~~at~~ at halftime was to come out in the second half and try to get within 10 points with 10 minutes in the game.

Tonight we played in spurts like a freshman and sophomore team does. Everybody was guilty of missing a shot and making emotional mistakes. We played very immature tonight. We did it time after time, it's a typical thing and I don't know how to control it.

Florida State is in the top 64. If they are not, there should be some kind of investigation. They are a seasoned team with depth and I wish them well. There should be four teams from Florida in the final 64. That is counting FSU, Florida, Jacksonville and Stetson. Don't count Stetson out.

We are still trying but we will carry our end of the stick before it's over.
