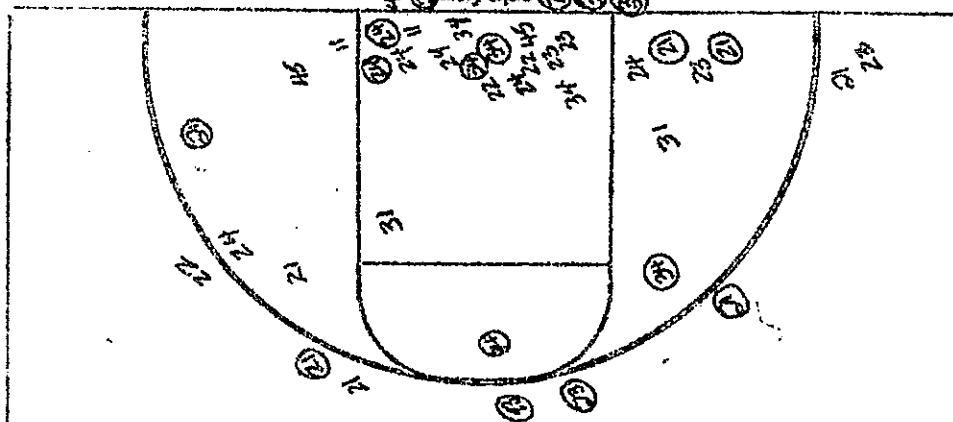

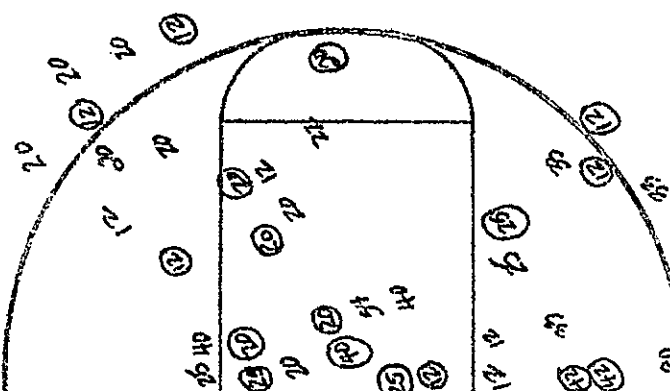

NCAA BASKETBALL SHOT CHART

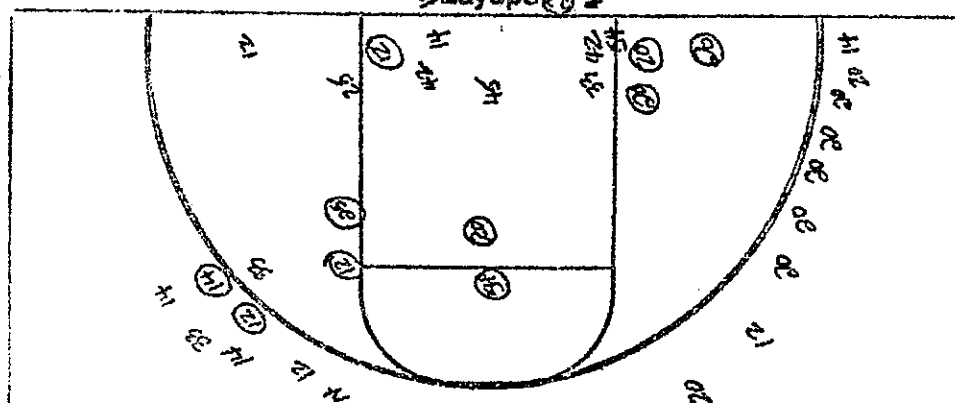

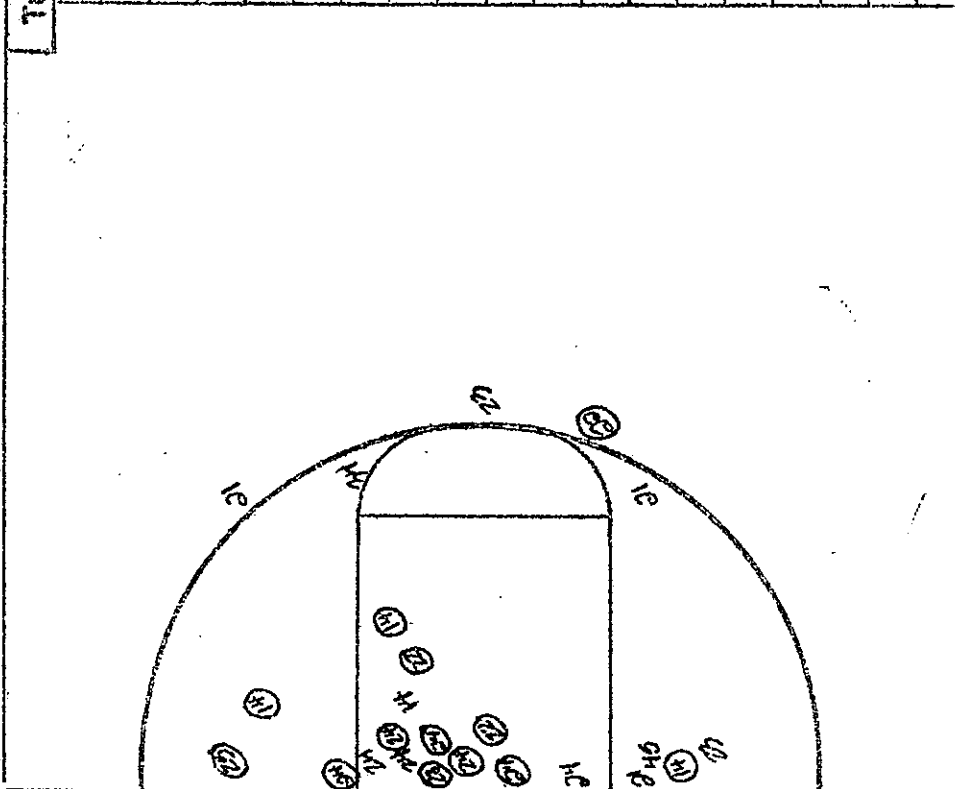

VIRGINIA TECH COACH FRANKIE ALLEN

"FSU played excellent basketball down the stretch. They made their big plays and free throws. That's what you have to do and they did that tonight. It was a game of spurts. We'd make a run, they'd make a run. The last three minutes they controlled the game. We put them on the line and they cashed it in.

(About Lancaster)

"We are a team that shoots the three pointer. FSU did a good job of contesting his shot--bodying up on him. I also thought he became impatient at times. A lot of teams will try to stop one of them (Coles or Lancaster) and that opened things up for Vernell.

FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH PAT KENNEDY

"It was obviously an important win for us. It was a big win for us. Beating them handily was very, very important for us. That gives us more Division I wins than last year and I think that's a great accomplishment for these kids.

We got great bench support ~~WHE~~ from Brad Johnson with 12 points and Derrick Mitchell. I thought Jerome Fitchett played well. We stayed active in our delay game. I think when you put those things together we had a good game.

(About not losing at the end). I think that's a sign of getting better.

I think our kids look back and see seven games and about 14 points that could have been different outcomes. I think we're getting better and I think that will help us in the Metro Conference tournament.

(Defensive plan on Lancaster) Derrick Mitchell did a great job at the end of the game. He forced Lancaster and Coles to shoot off balance. We had to play them man to man and hope they miss the three pointer. They (Lancaster and Coles) are tremendous players. They're both hard to stop."
