

FLORIDA STATE HEAD COACH PAT KENNEDY
"This is the type of game that can help a team mature early. After
the South Florida game we had a meeting and simply said that we
could not use our youth as an excuse. Tonight we did a good job
of executing our game plan.

"Derrick Carroll and Bobby Sura realy did a great job of providing leadership.

"Florida is a great basketball team. They are definitely an NCAA team. Talent wise, they are as good a Florida team as the Vernon Maxwell days. As far as where we stand, our goal is to remain in the top half of the ACC. This year, that's going to be difficult.

"We were able to press tonight for the first time, because we got Chuckie Graham and couple of extra players back. Against South Florida, we could not do that because we simply did not have the bodies.

"Bobby's (Sura) is in the back of the room and since you're going to ask him anyways, the deal with the Florida Assistant coach is no big thing. It's just something that happened, he apologized for it and it's over.

"Andre Reid just needs some time to become a force on this team. We don't have a lot of time for that to happen, but I was impressed with the way he hung in there in the second half. He grabbed some big rebounds, made some shots and stayed in the game despite being in foul trouble.

Bobby Sure on the pushing incident
"It was no big deal. I was diving to save a ball and ended up in a couple of coaches laps. I was pushed in the face and neck area and I threw the ball at him. I was wrong to retaliate. It's just something that happened and it's no problem."

LON KRUGER, FLORIDA HEAD COACH

"It was a ball game where each team had their opportunities. We made an early second half run but FSU made a run in the second half and took advantage of the opportunity. It was disappointing that we didn't take advantage of our own opportunities, but we have to learn by the results."

"We didn't handle the press very well. We were very timid. It was a combination of FSU's size and quickness that had an effect on the game."

"We didn't give Demitri Hill much support on the inside. He was the only one that was comfortable on the inside bonight. Marti and Sven seemed tentative tonight. We took poor shots early in the first half and settled for the perimeter. We didn't finish iside."

"I'didn't see the incident on the bench. It was behind me. R.C. mentioned to me after the game that he had made a mistake and didn't handle the situation well. He also said the same thing to Coach Kennedy immediately after the game."
