## 1996 ACC Tournament Coaches Quotes

### Game 1

Florida State 80 North Carolina State 65

Pat Kennedy, Florida State

"First, I want to congratulate Les, N.C. State and Todd Fuller, who is a great senior. I think when you evaluate a team, you look at close games. That's certainly a team that could have 18, 19 or 20 wins and be headed to the NCAA Tournament. They certainly earned it, and I'm happy for Les Robinson.

"In terms of us, we played about as poorly as we can play. We thought we had about 25 really good minutes at Maryland. We got down by 17 and took a seven point lead. Go back to North Carolina. Just a few weeks ago, we played just about 40 minutes of very good basketball.

(On the 19-0 start.) "We had some strange starts this year. At Georgia Tech, a start like that hurt us and we couldn't battle back from it. Again, we played so poorly. We had four assists and 18 turnovers, and even in games we lost this year we've never had anything close to that. So there's very little I can get out of this game from our side.

"As a coach, you certainly scratch your head. You back to the last time we had something like this, at Georgia Tech with the flight to Huntsville, Ala. and getting in at 1 a.m. If you take the trip into Maryland and getting in at 3:30 or 4 a.m., and you turn around and come up here. We practiced last night, and maybe we shouldn't have. We practiced hard for 45 minutes to an hour. I don't know if we were exhausted, but we had nothing mentally or physically. Between the Duke and Carolina game we didn't practice and came out fresh as a bell against Carolina. So the travel and the snow-in game -- as a coach, you have to look at that. But it doesn't change the outcome of the game."

Les Robinson, North Carolina State

"As you saw out there, it was not easy. I didn't think that game was ever going to end. I guess we're the only team in the league that's been through two clock situations that held up the game that long. I think it broke both teams mentally a little bit and caused it to be a little bit sloppy, but both teams played very hard. I think we played smart and we executed against a very athletic and talented Florida State team, a team that, needless to say, we were extremely concerned about. Our team has played well most of the season, even going back to Carolina. I told our guys before the game that we've played everyone close. Even that game at Carolina was a two-point game with a second or two to go in the half. We've been in every game. The margin hasn't varied that much and tonight we were able to get over the hump and hold onto a lead. That early pad was very significant, but Florida State's been behind at times by over 20 points. They're a very good comeback team. They've been behind against some real good teams and came back and won. So I knew they were very capable, so that's even more significant for our young men to play intelligently and play as a team. A team that has lost some close games, you tend to worry about games like this.

[On getting past first round] "I like our chances if we got by the first round a lot better than if we didn't. We're going to go to bed tonight and get up in the morning feeling the best about ourselves that we have in a long time. We're playing a team [Georgia Tech] that we just played even for 40 minutes, but we also know that we're playing the Atlantic Coast Conference champions. That's an opportunity. We're certainly an underdog, but we've proven that we can play with anyone in the league. They've got maybe the perimeter team in the country, and [Eddie] Elisma has really come on. We're going to have to do a better job on him."
