**COACHES QUOTES**

Maryland Head Coach Gary Williams

"It was just so great to get started. When you don't play that first day, there's a tendency to get a little anxious because you don't know how you're going to play. The players know that this is a big deal here at the ACC Tournament, and I like the way we responded. Florida State had a great win last night, a gut-check win, and we knew they'd come out tough those first few minutes. We knew we had to stay as tough as they were, and then obviously we're fresher and we're a little bit deeper than they are. I thought if we could get seven or eight guys into the game and playing, it would be to our advantage. I really liked the contribution of our bench today. Mike Mardesich and Juan Dixon really stepped up, and Danny Miller played probably his best game of the year. All of our seniors have done a great job of including the younger players into the team early, and it really pays off during the year. Both Laron Profit and Terrell Stokes have been very consistent for us and that's the key. The other players always know exactly what they're going to get from these two guys when they're on the floor. Of course, with the loss of Obinna Ekezie, their role as leaders has stepped up a little more and they've done a great job.

[On smiling on the bench] "After 10 years I screwed up . . . I have a lot of respect for Steve Robinson and what he has done at Florida State. The smile was with the players on the bench. I was just very happy with the way things were going.

Terrell Stokes:

"Our defense was good today. We got some easy buckets in transition and that got us running a lot. We executed our offense very well."

Laron Profit:

"I think our defensive pressure was a big issue. We got in the passing lanes and we were able to get them out of what they wanted to do. The second thing is that we rebounded much better than we did when we played at Florida State, and that enabled us to get out on the fast break."

Florida State Coach Steve Robinson

"There's not a lot to add to what's been said. Maryland played an outstanding game. They are a lot quicker and a lot faster. I'm not sure that the game yesterday didn't take more out of us than I'd hoped. We expended a lot of energy yesterday. We fought hard and had to go into overtime. That's not an excuse. Maryland did a tremendous job.

"We gave everything we had, it just wasn't enough. They just kept coming and coming. They opened up the second half with five points quickly off the bat and we never seemed to recover."

On Terrell Baker

"It has been great having an opportunity to coach him. He is a competitor and his spirit, heart and drive make coaching him very enjoyable. His exuberance on the court has been outstanding."
