Florida State University tennis team won its 10th straight court match Friday and Saturday by beating Middle Georgia College of Cochran, 9-0, and the Savannah branch of the University of Georgia, 9-0.

The Florida lads picked up a 5-4 baseball victory over their Cochran opponents on the diamond Friday but dropped the Saturday fray, 9-4 to the University of Georgia.

Handing the University of Georgia its first links defeat of the season, the FSU lads led with a 12½-5½ match score yesterday.
