Right-hander John Witt, West Palm Beach, who pitched the opening day victory over Ole Miss, had a three-hit game going into the seventh, However, he loosened and the Oglethorpe nine bunched three of their eight hits to score four times.

George Boyd walked to open the Seminole half of the first and Gresham rapped a single to center. Sam Cox was safe on a fielder's choice. Boy scored on an error, and Gresham and Cox went home on an overthrow.
