## STETSON 4-FSU 2

Stetson University won the first of a two-game series from Florida State University Friday afternoon with a 4-2 win over the Seminoles on the West campus field.

It was the sixth loss of the year for FSU and a close pitching duel between the Hatters' Brad Smith and the Indians' Royce Burt.

Smith gave up seven hits, one more than Burt doled out, but the Hatters bunched three of theirs in the fifth for a like number of runs to take a lead they never lost. Late Rally

The Seminoles were held scoreless until the ninth when a tworun uprising fell short. George Boyd, pinch-hitting for Burt, shot a single to left, but Moe Allen flied out, and Greasy Gresham struck

Then Sam Cox popped a single into left-center and raced to second as Boyd dashed in with a run. Ronald Melton, who led the FSU batters with two hits, rapped a long fly just inside the right field foul line that was dropped by Hatter Jim Jenkens, and Cox scored. The rally was halted when Lamar Brown grounded out, second to first.

The Seminoles left 11 men stranded. They threatened the fourth when they loaded the sacks with two away, and again in the sixth, but the clever hurling of Smith stopped the Indians each time.
