

Seminoles Beat Mocs

10-6 for Even Break

The Florida State University Seminoles gained an even break in their two-game baseball series with the Florida Southern College Moccasins by winning Saturday afternoon's error filled contest here 10 to 6. The Mocs took Friday's game 4-2.

The victory boosted the Seminoles' Dixie Conference record to 3 wins against a single loss while Florida Southern has a 1-1 mark within the circuit.

Florida State gained its winning margin when it shuttled four runs across the plate in the third inning to take a 7-3 lead. A walk to Augie Pompella and singles by Lamar Brown and Ronald Melton filled the bases with nobody out. FSU Centerfielder Fluke Tolle then dropped Les Mullen's long fly ball, allowing Pompella and Brown to score. Melton and Mullen also were waved across the plate when Southern pitcher D C Kinlaw knocked down Tolle's throw-in by losing his glove at it.

Witt Settles Down

Florida Southern picked up a run in the top of the fourth, but Seminole hurler John Witt blanked the Mocs the remaining five frames to take the victory.
