DELAND, Apr 20—Stetson's strong Hatters followed up Friday's 3-0 victory over Florida State University with a 3-2 triumph over the Seminoles today to sweep the two-game series from the hitherto once-beaten squad.

Ozzie Grasso was tagged for nine hits, but he kept them well-scattered and limited the Indians to single runs in the third and ninth innings despite five errors committed by his teammates.

The Hatters bunched their five blows off husky Ed Lockard to send the Seminole ace down to his first defeat of the season.

STETSON RALLIES

After trailing through the first five frames, the Hatters got to Lockard for two runs in the sixth and then punched the ultimate margin of victory across in the eighth inning.

The win gave Stetson a record of six wins in its last seven starts and clean sweeps over two state powerhouses. They had recently taken a two-game set from the Miami Hurricanes.

The two defeats left FSU with a record of nine wins and three losses.

Coach Charlie Armstrong's Indians are idle next week until Friday when they move up to Athens, Ga. to play the University of Georgia Bulldogs in a two-game series.
