ATHENS, Ga. Apr 28—Captain Charley Kell spoiled Florida State's hopes of a clean sweep over the Georgia baseball team today, turning back the Seminoles, 2-0, with a neat four-hit shut-out.

Les Mullen and Augie Pompelle, Seminole center fielder and short-stop respectively, accounted for all four of the Seminole singles, but couldn't get around to score.

Bob Whitmer was the losing pitcher. He and Kell fanned five men each, but the Bulldogs smashed seven hits off Whitmer. Jack Roberts doubled in the fourth and came home on Sonny Dykes' single to center. In the sixth, Roberts lived on an error and scored when Dykes pumped a triple to right center.

The Seminole infield pulled two snappy double plays in the fast ball game, which lasted only an hour and 46 minutes.
