

## Georgia Nine Stops FSU, 3-0

TALLAHASSEE— (AP)— Pitcher Jack Roberts was sharp on the mound and at bat yesterday as he led the University of Georgia Bulldogs to a 3-0 baseball victory over Florida State University here.

Roberts gave up only five hits, struck out 11 Seminoles and drove in Georgia's final run in the ninth inning with a triple — the only extra base hit of the game.

It was the first loss of the young season for FSU, which had won its first two games. It gave Georgia a record of three wins against a single loss. The FSU team will meet the Jacksonville [Ala.] State Teachers College here Tues.
