DeLAND, April 11—The Seminoles came from behind here today to score three runs in the sixth and five in the ninth and defeat Stetson 8-2. The win gives FSU an 8-7 edge over the Hatters in their series dating back to 1948.

Pitcher-outfielder Max Long's one-run homer was the big blow in FSU's three-run sixth while Ralph Blinn's three-run triple sparked the ninth inning outburst which iced the decision.

Long got credit for the win, his second of the season, against a loss.
