ATHENS, Ga.—Florida State University's Seminoles, who had hoped to tune up for their bitter intra-state series with Stetson this weekend by beating Georgia, bowed to the Bulldogs 12-6 yesterday.

A six-run outburst against starter Jim Atwood in the first three frames and a 10-hit attack that was sparked by Johnny Clifton's two long home runs were too much for the Seminoles to handle against the Southeastern Conference leaders. Clifton homered in the first and seventh and drove in four runs.

Sophomore Allan Parrish got the win, his fifth of the season without a loss. Atwood absorbed the defeat.

The victory was the 17th of the year for the Bulldogs against only three losses. The defeat was FSU's eighth against 11 wins and a tie.

Bob Hudson and Ralph Blinn cracked the Seminoles' 11-hit attack with two blows apiece. One of Hudson's went for three bases. FSU plays Stetson in Tallahassee on Friday and Saturday.
