Florida State got its fourth straight masterful pitching effort from freshman Tommy Garcia and the Seminoles chimed in with 16 hits to rout Stetson's Hatters, 16-2, here yesterday.

It was a convincing turn-about from Monday's Florida Intercollegiate Conference series opener with the Hatters, won by Stetson, 8-7.

Garcia, 180-pound yearling from Fort Myers, was in complete control, taming the Hatters on five hits for his fourth triumph without a loss.

Only one of Stetson's two runs off Garcia — an eighth-inning solo homer by first baseman Hugh McInnis — was earned. FSU's leading hurler, Garcia has surrendered only three earned runs in 31 innings.

Held to seven hits by southpaw Bud Reynolds Monday, Danny Litwhiler's Seminoles erupted for 16—six for extra bases — against four Stetson pitchers yesterday.

First baseman Fred Twomey, only a sophomore, continued his long-range blasting with a double, triple, and home run, his third

of the season. Garcia lifted his

first college home run over the left field wall at FSU's East Campus diamond.

Veteran centerfielder Bob Hudson belted a triple and two singles and Riley Beavers of Tallahassee laced four singles in as many trips to boost his team-leading batting average to .444 for 11 games.

Night Seminoles joined in the batting barrage. Frank Singletary, first of a quartet of sophomore pitchers, suffered his second loss and Stetson its fourth setback in seven games.

The Seminoles have a creditable 8-3 record, 3-1 in conference play.

Senior second baseman Billy Campbell was ejected from the game in the fifth inning by base umpire TV Braswell. Campbell disputed a call by Braswell on a close play at second and was sent to the showers.
