

Florida State scored its 16th baseball victory of the season here Saturday afternoon, overwhelming Stetson, 23-2, with 21 hits and eight stolen bases.

The Tribe, 8-1 winner over Stetson here Friday night, has won all four of its starts in Florida Intra collegiate Baseball Conference play.

Max Long picked up the victory for FSU, his sixth without a loss. He worked the first six frames before giving away to a trio of relievers.

George Hehemann pitched the seventh for the winners, southpaw John Bristol the eighth and Fred

Kenney finished up in the ninth. Long and Hehemann were each touched for a single run by Hatter batsmen.

At the plate, shortstop Dick Howser continued to shine for the Seminoles. The 140-pound converted outfielder got four hits in five trips, including a triple. Right-fielder Bob Rosell was the leading RBI man for the Tribe, driving in four.

As usual, Danny Litwhiler had the Tribe running. Lee Corso got three of the eight stolen bases. In the bottom of the third, Corso walked and then stole second, third and home.

The Hatters, only behind 3-1 at the time, were visibly shaken and proved it as the Tribe poured 20 runs across in its final five at-bats.
